Dear Merchants and Residents,

Warner Bros. Pictures is in production for the upcoming feature film entitled, *Extremely Loud & Incredibly Close*. The project is an adaptation of the book by Jonathan Safran Foer and will be directed by Stephen Daldry (*The Reader, The Hours, Billy Elliot*).

We are scheduled to film in your area on:
WEDNESDAY, APRIL 20, 2011
From approximately **6:00AM** until **9:00PM**

For the purposes of staging scenes, parking equipment and production vehicles, and rigging and de-rigging equipment, **PARKING** will be held in advance of filming on these blocks:

- **5th Avenue between East 72nd Streets – East 77th Streets**
- **Cherry Hill Circle & Entrance Roads (per Central Park Conservancy)**
- **West 64th Street between Central Park West & Broadway (Catering Trucks only)**
- **East 72nd Street between 5th Avenue & Madison Avenue**

In order to avoid holding parking spaces many days in advance of filming, we will use the Vehicle Tow Unit (VTU) of the NYPD to relocate any remaining vehicles parked in our designated parking areas prior to filming. We will post signs 48 hours in advance of relocation. There is no cost or penalty to owners of relocated vehicles. In the event that your vehicle is relocated, contact our **Location Department at 917.626.6851, NYPD Vehicle Tow Unit at 212.971.0780 X 231 / 232, OR 311** and someone will tell you where your vehicle can be found. We urge you to pay attention to the signs to avoid any inconvenience. This is the same program that is used for parades and other public events throughout the city. Please be assured that we will release any unused parking whenever possible.

We understand that filming can be somewhat disruptive, and we appreciate your cooperation. If you have special needs such as deliveries, moving, traveling, or construction, please contact the Locations Department. As guests in your neighborhood, we will make every effort to be respectful of the daily routine of the community.
