Paul Krikler welcomed attendees and introduced Bryant Daniels, Roosevelt Island Operating Corporation (RIOC) Director of Communications & Community Affairs.

Item 1 – RIOC Update (4:28)

Bryant Daniels provided updates on:

- Upcoming work on the tram entrance, which will not impact the schedule

- Challenges with transportation to off-island schools, including tram overcrowding and subway unreliability
