



IMPORTANT NOTICE

Lane Reduction on Second Avenue Beginning on or around January 23rd, 2012

In support of the Second Avenue Subway (SAS) project, MTA contractors will be **reducing Second Avenue to three traffic lanes** (from four traffic lanes) from 101st Street to 99th Street. This change will occur the week of January 23rd, 2012. This lane reduction is necessary for preparation of slurry wall installation due to the size of the equipment being utilized.

There will be three lanes of traffic maintained at all times. Furthermore, NYPD Traffic Enforcement Agents will be placed at the intersections of Second Avenue and 101st, 100th, and 99th Streets. This lane reduction will be in place through the summer of 2012.

Please note the scope and nature of construction activities are subject to change based upon field conditions. All work has been approved by appropriate City agencies where required. We appreciate your patience during construction.
