

93RD STREET ACCESS

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Intermittent Closures of 93rd Street (between Second and First Avenues) Beginning on or around January 23rd, 2012

In support of the Second Avenue Subway (SAS) project, MTA contractors will begin secant pile installation on 93rd Street between Second Avenue and First Avenue, beginning Monday, January 23rd, 2012. This work may require 93rd Street, between Second Avenue and First Avenue, to be closed temporarily due to the size and location of the operation and its proximity to vehicular traffic. The roadway will be reopened at night after daytime construction activities are completed.

The intermittent closures will only occur when absolutely necessary, and last roughly until Summer 2012. Flaggers will be positioned at both ends of 93rd Street, at Second Avenue and First Avenue, to facilitate the flow of traffic and/or pedestrians as appropriate. If you are driving or taking a taxi to the street, please carry this flyer with you and present it to the flagger at First Avenue and 93rd Street.

All in-block vehicular traffic, must enter at 93rd Street at First Avenue. A flagger will be posted there to allow vehicles to enter and exit. Drivers and pedestrians should be aware that when 93rd Street is closed, the street between Second and First Avenues will be temporarily two-way, and drivers and pedestrians should look both ways. Please note the loading and unloading for the Waterford building will be located at the eastern edge of the work zone on 93rd Street.

Please note the scope and nature of construction activities are subject to change based upon field conditions. All work has been approved by appropriate City agencies where required. We appreciate your patience during construction.
