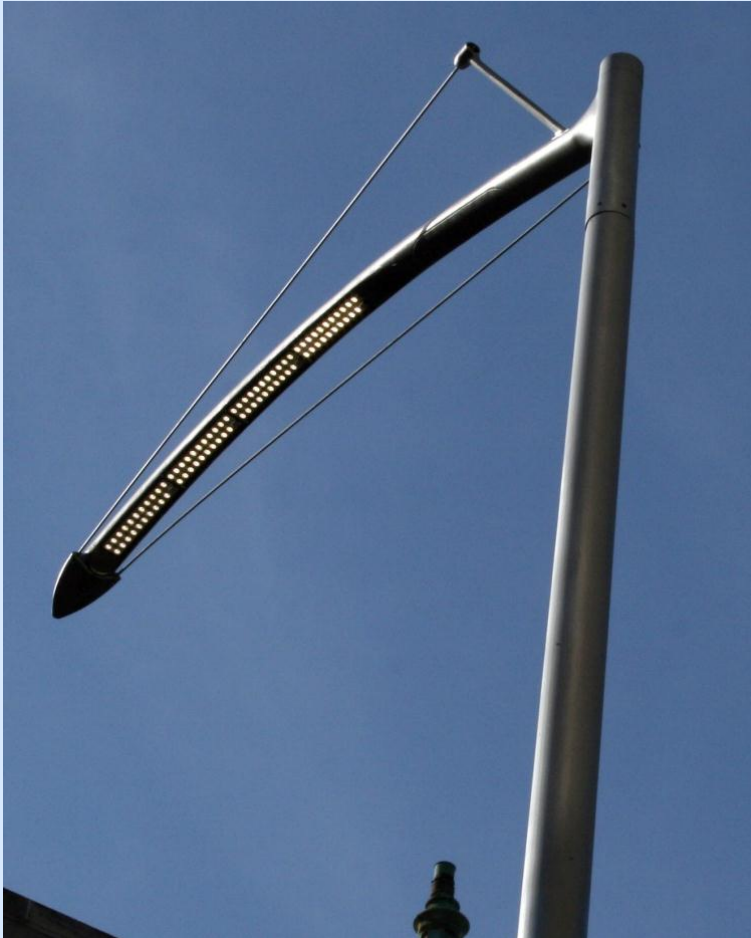

Bald Cypress



- Strong pyramidal shape
- Orange/brown fall color

Sweetgum



- Strong, yellow fall color

- Maroon fall color

- Large, tropical leaves
- Yellow fall color

Elm



- Yellow fall color

- One of the most common street trees
- Yellow fall color

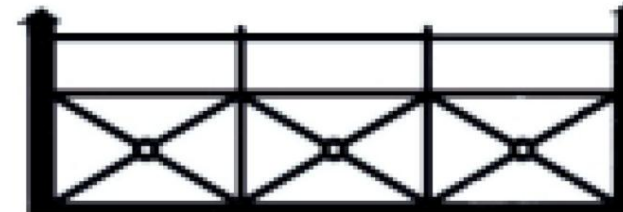
A– Traditional Wicket

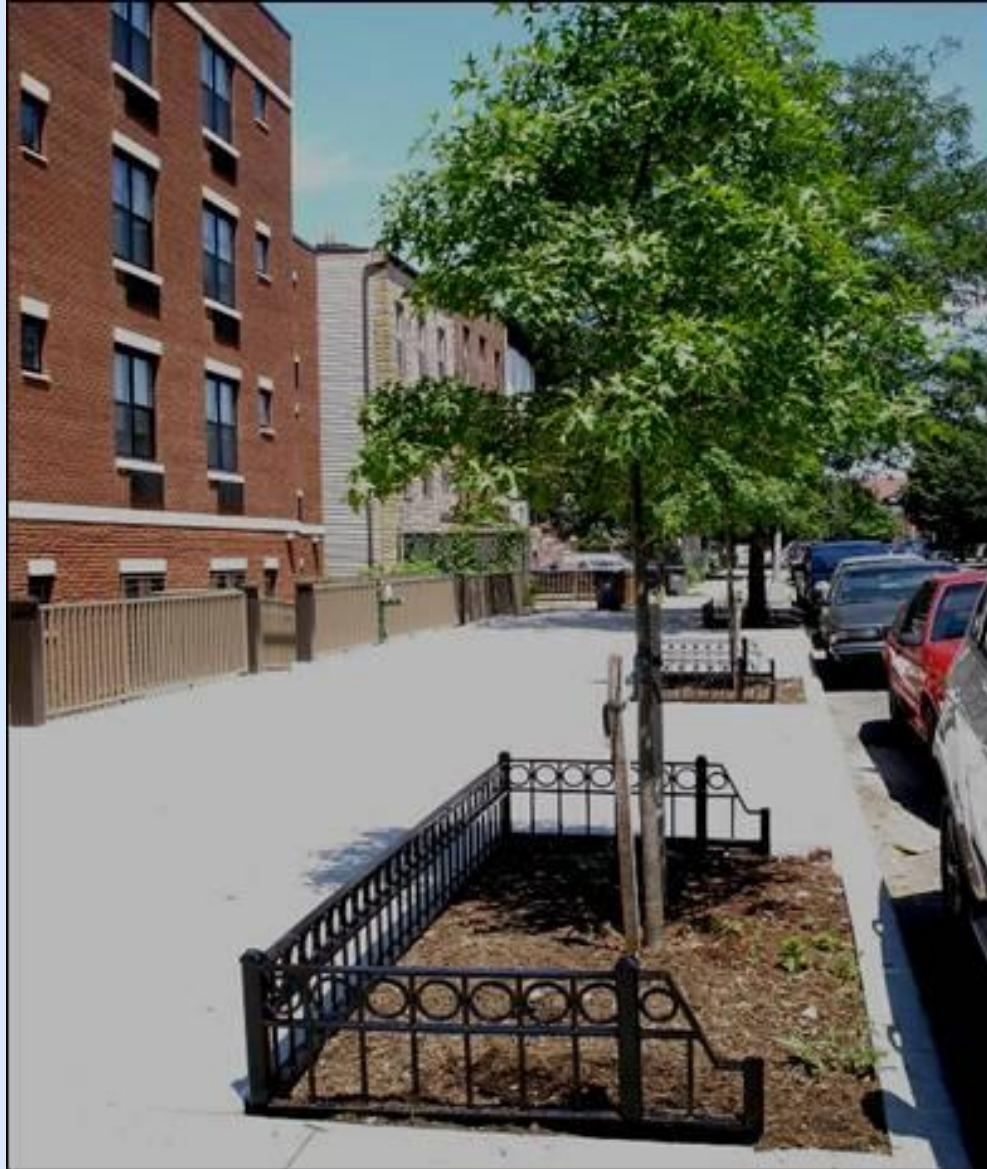
