## In order to enhance safety and mobility DOT will be making the following improvements on First Avenue between East 61st and East 72nd streets:

- A parking-protected bicycle path will be installed
- Left-turn lanes will be installed at intersections, mitigating left-turn conflicts
- Concrete pedestrian refuge islands will be built to shorten crossing distances and improve safety at nine intersections.
