Subject: Full Closure of East 83rd Street between 1st and 2nd Avenue

Dear Ms. Ludorf:

We are writing this letter as per note 77 on contract drawing CM0004 to inform you of our intent to close 83rd Street heading west from 1st Avenue to 2nd Avenue to allow for the construction of temporary site utilities across 83rd Street, signal improvements to the 83rd Street intersection, and sidewalk repairs on the south side of 83rd Street.

The road must be closed due to the narrow width of 83rd Street at the 2nd Avenue intersection which prevents construction equipment from operating safely while maintaining pedestrian and vehicular traffic flow. STJV plans to put a flagman at the intersection of 83rd Street and 1st Avenue and will only allow local traffic to enter or leave the block. STJV will also provide a second flagger that will be available to escort vehicles up the block and/or out of the block as needed. The second flagger can be called upon via radio or Nextel by the one dedicated flagger at 1st Ave. Additional flagmen will be provided as necessary to direct pedestrian traffic around work areas.

The dates to perform this work will be Wednesday, April 18 thru Friday, May 4, 2012, and the closure would be from 9 AM to 4 PM.
