Program Background

- Row of bike racks installed in the street along the curb
- 31 bike corrals city wide
- Locations are determined through application process
- Maintenance partner keeps site clear of debris and snow, sustains plantings, and reports abandoned bicycles



E 9th St and 2nd Av, Manhattan
Installed: May 2013
Maintained by: Mudspot Coffee



Broome St and Allen St, Manhattan
Installed: October 2013
Maintained by: Dudley's Cafe

Physical Guidelines

- Curbside lane never used for travel
- Minimum of 15' away from fire hydrants
- May not block crosswalks, driveways, utility covers



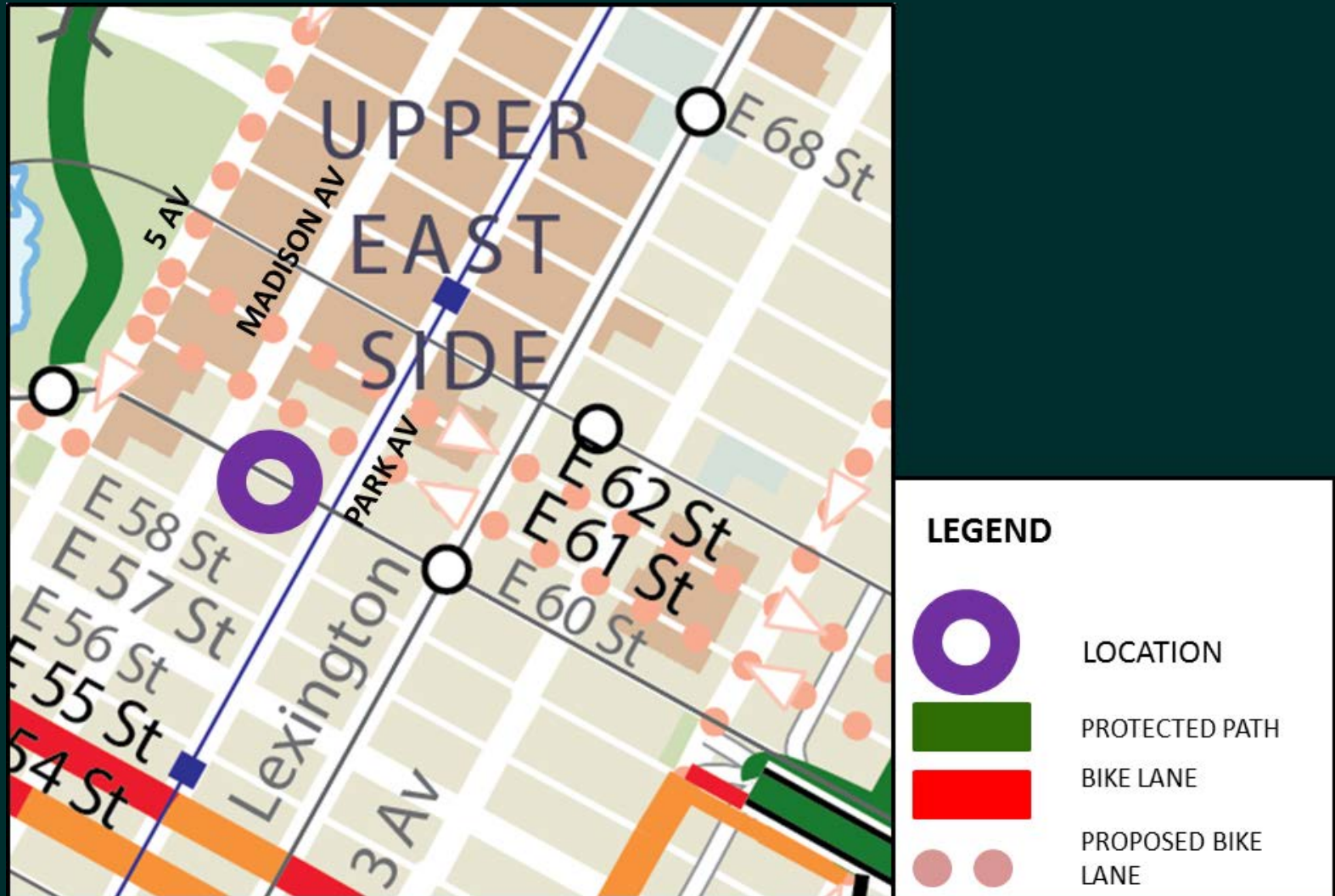
Rivington St and Essex St, Manhattan
Installed: May 2013
Maintained by: Teanyssimo



Elizabeth St and Prince St, Manhattan
Installed: September 2012
Maintained by: Café Habana

Proposed Location

- Le Bilboquet Restaurant applied for corral and has agreed to maintain the site



Existing Conditions

- Insufficient parking for neighborhood needs
- Bikes locked up to bus stops and street signs indicate demand for legal bike parking



Proposed Improvements

- Bike corral with space for 8 bicycles
- 2 large planter pots
- Flexible delineators
- Parking lane line stripe
- Remove 1 loading space on south side of street

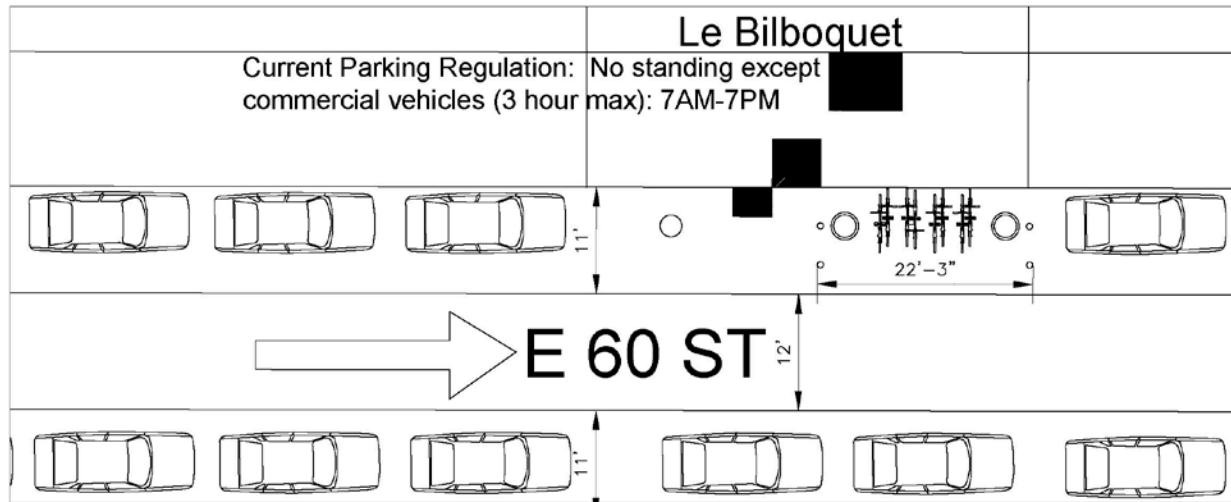
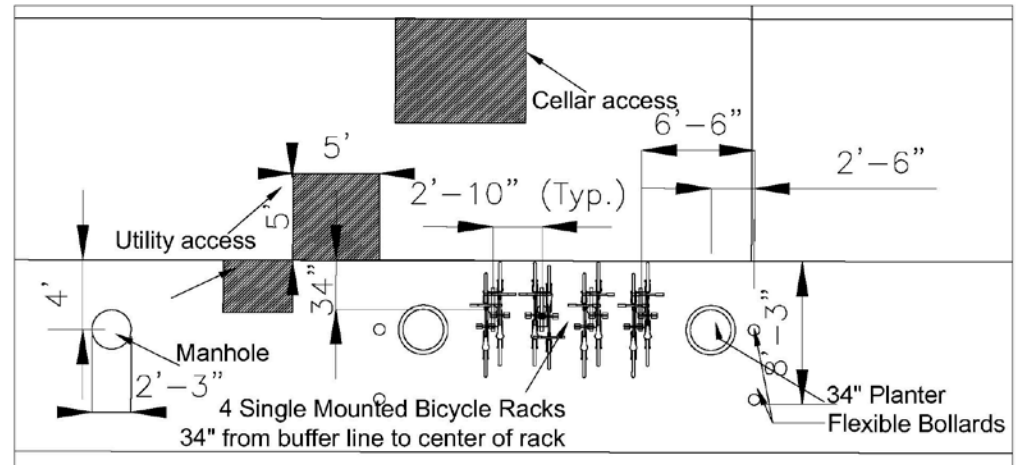
Draft Site Plan v 3/12/2014
