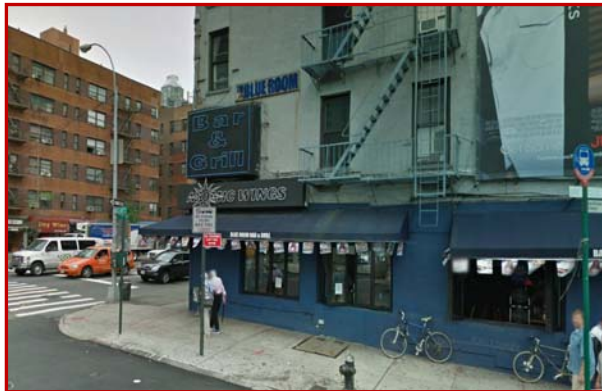

During the summer of 2012, the Division of Bridges began replacement of the wearing surface of the Upper Roadways and the bikeway/walkway of the Queensboro Ed Koch Bridge. This work required removal of the existing surface and repairs to the base pavement. The path is now ready for the installation of the final surface pavement. This will require the complete closure of the path to accommodate the personnel and equipment for the paving operation. Due to scheduling problems this work has now been rescheduled from this weekend to **Friday, October 5<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m Saturday morning October 6<sup>th</sup>**. To accommodate pedestrians and cyclists, a shuttle bus will be provided in both directions throughout the closure. This work is weather sensitive and if required will be rescheduled for Saturday October 6<sup>th</sup> at the same hours. We apologize for any inconvenience.

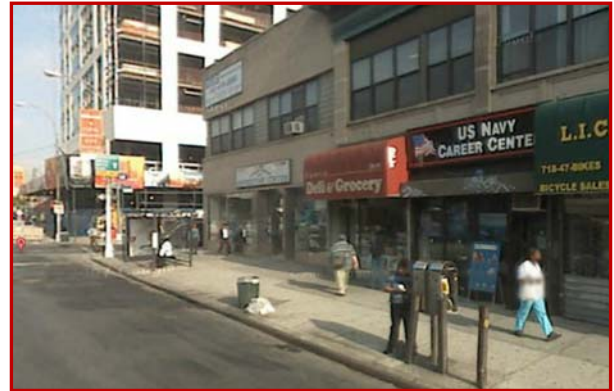
### **Manhattan Shuttle Stop**
