

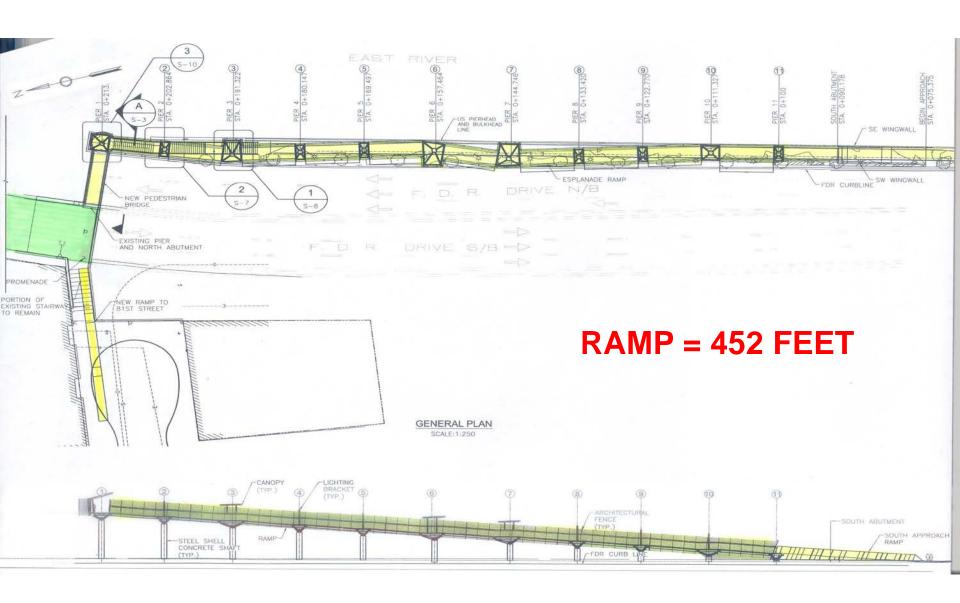






E81st STREET – PROPOSED PLAN, ELEVATION

















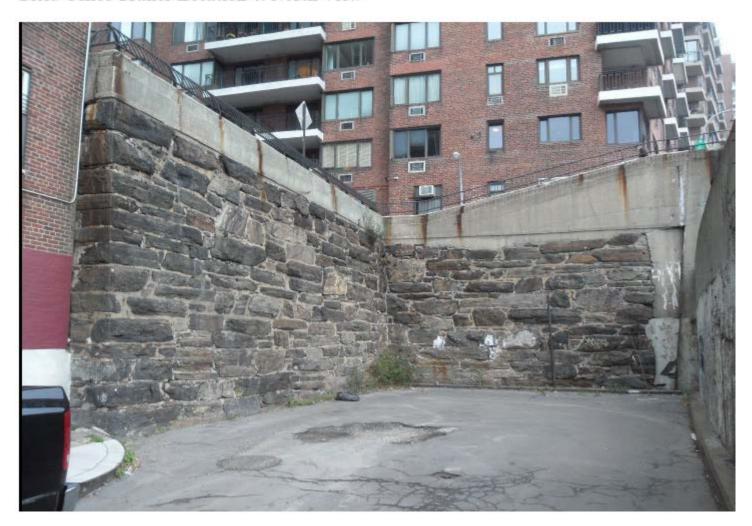


Cul-de-sac 84th Street and East End Ave.

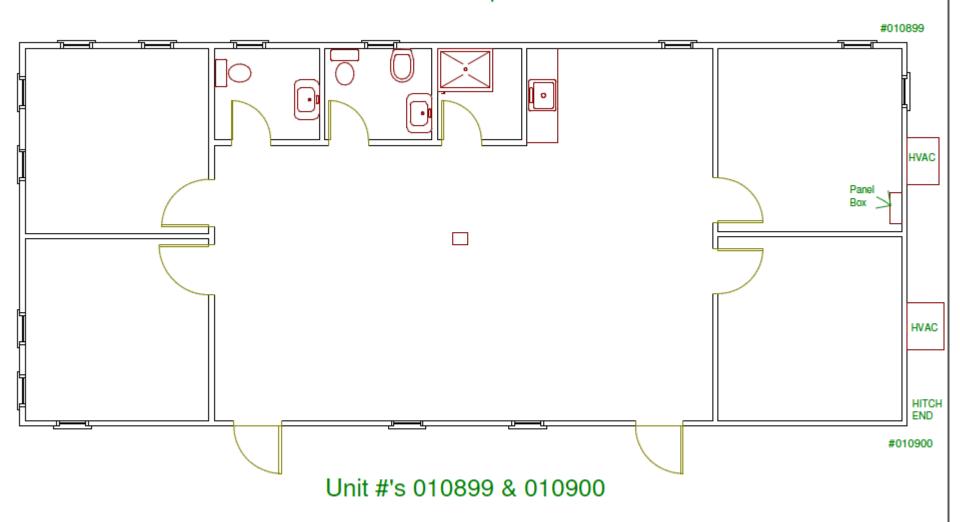




Field Office Trailer Location 4: North View

Special Needs:

Rodent Control:

- A rodent survey will be performed prior to construction
- Rodent Control Stations will be installed by a professional rodent control contractor



CITY DOT TRAFFIC STIPULATIONS DURING CONSTRUCTION

Access to Promenade will be maintained at all times Limited access to esplanade from 81st Street during construction.

FDR-One lane closure from 11 PM to 5 AM weekdays
Two lane closure from 1 AM to 5 AM weekdays
Full closure 15 minutes on the hour for erection
Two lane closure from midnight to 7 AM-Saturday
Two lane closure from 11 PM Saturday to 10 AM Sunday



KEEPING YOU INFORMED

- DDC will assign a Community Construction Liaison (CCL). The CCL will keep the community informed by:
 - Being the first point of contact between the project and the community
 - Identifying, addressing and/or resolving field inquiries & issues as well as any coordination between the project and needs of the affected stakeholders
 - Providing regular updates/advisories for the community to better plan around construction activities

COMMUNITY IMPACTS

- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times on the Promenade
- Temporary street closures and / or limited access may be necessary
- Uniformed NYPD traffic agents assigned on FDR when required.
- DDC will monitor operation and work within DEP Noise Code regulations
- Sidewalk and/or loading dock access from the curb may be temporarily restricted while work is conducted (coordination will be arranged on a case by case basis)
