


Important Notice Night Work Ed Koch Queensboro Bridge

Community Boards No. 1, Queens and No. 8, Manhattan

The New York City Department of Transportation (NYDOT) Division of Bridges will install rumble strips in the pavement of the south (Queens-bound) outer roadway of the Ed Koch - Queensboro Bridge beginning Saturday April 30th. Work will resume on Monday, May 2nd and, as this work is weather dependent, continue until Thursday, May 5th, as needed. The installation, through noise and vibration, is designed to attract attention of the motorist to the approaching curve in the roadway and to the need to reduce travel speed accordingly. Variable Message Boards will be positioned to alert motorists of this closing beginning Friday, April 22nd.
