



WEEKEND TRAFFIC ADVISORY
Friday May 6, 2011 to Sunday, May 8, 2011

As part of its citywide traffic improvement program, the New York City Department of Transportation has compiled a list of areas where Street construction or Street events will impede the normal flow of traffic this weekend.

MANHATTAN

East 59th Street between 2nd Avenue and 3rd Avenue: This street will be closed from 7am to 4pm Saturday to facilitate NYCDDC trunk water main and utility work. Motorists should use alternate routes and posted detours to access Queensboro Bridge such as 2nd Avenue southbound or East 58th Street eastbound onto the Second Avenue contra flow lane.

2nd Avenue between East 88th Street and East 87th Street: Two lanes of traffic will be maintained 8am to 6pm Saturday and/or Sunday facilitate crane operation.

West 10th Street between Hudson Street and Bleecker Street: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 9am to 7pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 13th Street between Washington Avenue and 9th Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 6am to 1pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 30th Street between 10th Avenue and 11th Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 47th Street between Madison Avenue and Vanderbilt Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 12:01am to 8am to facilitate crane operation.

West 58th Street between 11th Avenue and 10th Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday 8am to 6pm to facilitate Con Edison roadway work.

West 58th Street between 7th Avenue and 6th Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 7am to 5pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 65th Street Transverse Road between Central Park West and 5th Avenue: This street will be closed Thursday 11pm to Friday 5am to facilitate crane operation.

West 66th Street between Central Park West and Columbus Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 67th Street between Broadway and Columbus Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday 9am to 7pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 68th Street between 5th Avenue and Madison Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 81st Street between Madison Avenue and 5th Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 84th Street between 3rd Avenue and 2nd Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

Suffolk Street between Rivington Street and Delancey Street: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 7am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

Thompson Street between West 3rd Street and Washington Square, South: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

Vanderbilt Avenue between East 46th Street and East 47th Street: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 12:01am to 8am to facilitate crane operation.

Wall Street between Pearl Street and Water Street: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 6pm and Sunday from 9am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

Stone Street between Hanover Square and Coenties Alley; Mill Lane between Stone Street and South Williams Street: These streets will be closed Friday April 1, 2011 to Wednesday November 30, 2011 for the Stone Street Pedestrian Mall Event as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

The above streets will be closed Saturday from 10am to 2pm for the National Association of Mental Illness Parade as permitted by NYPD.

3rd Avenue between East 14th Street and East 23rd Street: This street will be closed Saturday from 11am to 6pm for the Gramercy Visiting Neighbors Third Avenue Festival Event as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

3rd Avenue between East 23rd Street and East 34th Street: These streets will be closed Saturday from 11am to 6pm for the Gustavos Adolphus Lutheran Church Third Avenue Expo as permitted by the Mayor's Office Street Activity Office (SAPO).

The above streets will be closed Saturday from 11am to 6pm for the Cures Not Wars Event as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

Amsterdam Avenue between West 96th Street and West 106th Street: This street will be closed Sunday from 11am to 6pm for the Valley Restoration LDC Amsterdam Avenue Festival Event as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

Central Park West between West 106th Street and West 92nd Street: This above streets will be closed Sunday from 3pm to 4:30pm for the Cinco De Mayo Parade as permitted by NYPD.

MANHATTAN/BROOKLYN

Brooklyn Bridge: This Bridge is closed to Manhattan-bound traffic overnight as of Monday night April 4th 2011 to perform necessary long term rehabilitation and repainting work. Brooklyn-bound traffic will be maintained throughout the project as will the span's pedestrian and cycling path. Motorists should follow signed routes to access the bridge leaving Manhattan. The northbound FDR exit to the Brooklyn Bridge is closed starting 1 hour before closure hours noted below. Motorists should use the prior South Street exit. The Brooklyn Queens Expressway eastbound exit to the Brooklyn Bridge is closed starting as early as 30 minutes before closure hours noted below. Motorists should proceed to the following Manhattan Bridge exit or use the prior Brooklyn Battery Tunnel (pay toll) exit for access to Manhattan. All work will occur overnight during off peak hours, when Manhattan-bound motorists will be detoured to the nearby Manhattan Bridge, or may choose other crossings. The full closure for traffic proceeding Manhattan bound/westbound overnight will occur Monday night through Friday morning between 11pm and 6am, Saturday 12:01am to 7am. These lane closures are necessary to facilitate NYCDOT Bridges rehabilitation work.

Brooklyn Bridge Eastbound: One of three lanes will be closed on Saturday from 7am to 2pm to facilitate NYCDOT Bridges maintenance work.

BRONX

Concourse Village West between East 159th Street and East 161st Street: This street will be closed Saturday from and or Sunday 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

Goble Place between Jerome Avenue and Inwood Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday 6am to 9pm to facilitate crane operation.

BROOKLYN/QUEENS

Grand Street over Newtown Creek: This bridge will be closed Saturday 7am to 3pm until May 14, 2011 to facilitate NYCDOT bridge repairs. Motorists should use the Metropolitan Avenue Bridge as an alternate.
