

# WEEKEND TRAFFIC ADVISORY Friday August 26, 2011 to Sunday August 28, 2011

As part of its citywide traffic improvement program, the New York City Department of Transportation has compiled a list of areas where Street construction or Street events will impede the normal flow of traffic this weekend.

Please be advised that all crane activity for this weekend August 27 through August 28, 2011 has been suspended by the Department of Buildings, due to the anticipated severe storm conditions.

### **MANHATTAN**

<u>East River Esplanade-South Street northbound from Whitehall Street to Old Slip;</u> northbound entrance to FDR Drive from South Street: These roadways will be closed nightly from 9pm to 5am, Monday night to Saturday morning to facilitate NYCEDC utility/roadway work.

<u>65<sup>th</sup> Street Central Transverse Road between Central Park West and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue</u>: This roadway will be closed from 12:01am to 6am Saturday to facilitate NYCDOT bridge inspection work.

Nassau Street between Fulton Street and Beekman Street; Ann Street between Nassau Street and Park Row; Intersection of Nassau Street and Ann Street: These streets will be closed from 8am to 10pm Saturday and 9am to 10pm Sunday to facilitate NYCDDC roadway work.

Stone Street between Hanover Square and Coenties Alley; Mill Lane between Stone Street and South Williams Street: These streets will be closed Friday April 1, 2011 to Wednesday November 30, 2011 for the Stone Street Pedestrian Mall Event as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

<u>East 4<sup>th</sup> Street between 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and Bowery</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 11am to 6pm for the DOT/Weekend Walks FAB as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

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<u>Lexington Avenue between East 57<sup>th</sup> Street and East 42<sup>nd</sup> Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 11am to 6pm for the Friends of Dag Hammarskjold Festival as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

- Greenwich Street between Barclay Street and Vesey Street
- West Broadway between Barclay Street and Vesey Street
- Barclay Street between West Street and Broadway

The above streets will be closed Saturday from 8am to 4pm for the World Police and Fire Games-7 World Trade Center Stair Climb as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

- Edgecombe Avenue between 135<sup>th</sup> Street and 136<sup>th</sup> Street Route:
- Edgecombe Avenue between 136<sup>th</sup> Street and 155<sup>th</sup> Street
- Saint Nicholas Place between 155<sup>th</sup> Street and 150<sup>th</sup> Street
- 150<sup>th</sup> Street between Saint Nicholas Terrace and Convent Avenue
- Convent Avenue between Saint Nicholas Terrace and 127<sup>th</sup> Street
- 127<sup>th</sup> Street between Convent Avenue and Saint Nicholas Avenue
- Saint Nicholas Avenue between 127<sup>th</sup> Street and 138<sup>th</sup> Street

The above streets will be closed Saturday from 8:30am to 10am for the Percy Sutton Harlem Family Health Walk-A-Thon as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

# MANHATTAN/BROOKLYN

Brooklyn Bridge: This Bridge is closed to Manhattan-bound traffic overnight as of Monday night April 4<sup>th</sup> 2011 to perform necessary long term rehabilitation and repainting work. Brooklyn-bound traffic will be maintained throughout the project as will the span's pedestrian and cycling path. Motorists should follow signed routes to access the bridge leaving Manhattan. The northbound FDR exit to the Brooklyn Bridge is closed starting 1 hour before closure hours noted below. Motorists should use the prior South Street exit. The Brooklyn Queens Expressway eastbound exit to the Brooklyn Bridge is closed starting as early as 30 minutes before closure hours noted below. Motorists should proceed to the following Manhattan Bridge exit or use the prior Brooklyn Battery Tunnel (pay toll) exit for access to Manhattan. All work will occur overnight during off peak hours, when Manhattan-bound motorists will be detoured to the nearby Manhattan Bridge, or may choose other crossings. The full closure for traffic proceeding

Manhattan bound/westbound overnight will occur Monday night through Friday morning between 11pm and 6am, Saturday 12:01am to 7am and 12:01am to 9am Sunday. These lane closures are necessary to facilitate NYCDOT Bridges rehabilitation work.

<u>Brooklyn Bridge outbound/eastbound</u>: One of three outbound lanes will be closed 7am to 2pm Saturday to facilitate NYCDOT bridge maintenance work.

## **BROOKLYN/QUEENS**

<u>Metropolitan Avenue Bridge over Newtown Creek</u>: One of two lanes westbound will be closed Saturday from 7an to 1pm to facilitate NYCDOT bridge repair work.

## **QUEENS**

<u>46<sup>th</sup> Street between Queens Boulevard and Greenpoint Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 11am to 6pm for the DOT/Weekend Walks Sunnyside Summer Street as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office SAPO).

## **BRONX**

Grand Concourse between East 165<sup>th</sup> Street and Mosholu Parkway

- Mosholu Parkway between Van Cortlandt ark South and Southern Boulevard (Southbound and Northbound Lanes)
- Southern Boulevard between Fordham University Entrance and Traffic Circle (in front of Baseball Field)
- Sedgwick Boulevard between Goulden Avenue and Mosholu Parkway
- Paul Avenue between Mosholu Parkway and Bedford Boulevard West
- West 205<sup>th</sup> Street between Paul Avenue and Goulden Avenue
- Goulden Avenue between West 205<sup>th</sup> Street and Bedford Park Boulevard West
- Bedford Park Boulevard West between Goulden Avenue and Paul Avenue The above streets will be closed Sunday from 8am to 1pm for the Bronx Half Marathon as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).
