

WEEKEND TRAFFIC ADVISORY Friday April 22, 2011 to Sunday, April 24, 2011

As part of its citywide traffic improvement program, the New York City Department of Transportation has compiled a list of areas where Street construction or Street events will impede the normal flow of traffic this weekend.

MANHATTAN

<u>East 59th Street between 2nd Avenue and 3rdAvenue</u>: This street will be closed from 7am to 4pm Saturday to facilitate NYCDDC trunk water main and utility work. Motorists should use alternate routes and posted detours to access Queensboro Bridge such as 2nd Avenue southbound or East 58th Street eastbound onto the Second Avenue contra flow lane.

<u>West 25th Street between Avenue of the Americas and Broadway</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 30th Street between 10th Avenue and 11th Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 9am 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 46th Street 9th Avenue and 8th Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 67th Street between Columbus Avenue and Broadway</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 9am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Mercer Street between Broome Street and Spring Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Suffolk Street between Delancey Street and Rivington Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 7am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Gold Street between Fulton Street and John Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 6pm and Sunday from 9am to 6pm to facilitate Con Edison utility work.

<u>John Street between Broadway and Fulton Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 10am to 10pm to facilitate Con Edison utility work.

<u>Broad Street between South Street and Water Street</u>: This street will be closed Friday from 12 Noon to 6pm for the Downtown Independents Democratic Festival Event as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

- Vanderbilt Avenue between 42nd Street and 45th Street
- 43rd Street between Madison Avenue and Vanderbilt Avenue
- 44th Street between Madison Avenue and Vanderbilt Avenue

The above streets will be closed Friday and Saturday from 12 Noon to 7pm for the Earth Day Fair Event as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

<u>6th Avenue between West 42nd Street and West 56th Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 11am to 1:30pm for the International Gospel Uptown Event as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

<u>8th Avenue between West 14th Street and West 23rd Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 11am to 6pm for the Chelsea Visiting Neighbors 8th Avenue Festival Event as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

5th Avenue between 47th Street and 57th Street: This street will be closed Sunday from 10am to 2pm for the Easter Sunday Mass Event as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

MANHATTAN/BROOKLYN

Brooklyn Bridge: One of three lanes will be closed eastbound/outbound Saturday from 7am to 2pm to facilitate NYCDOT Bridges maintenance work

Brooklyn Bridge:

This Bridge is closed to Manhattan-bound traffic overnight as of Monday night April 4th 2011 to perform necessary long term rehabilitation and repainting work. Brooklyn-bound traffic will be maintained throughout the project as will the span's pedestrian and cycling path. Motorists should follow signed routes to access the bridge leaving Manhattan. The northbound FDR exit to the Brooklyn Bridge is closed starting 1 hour before closure hours noted below. Motorists should use the prior South Street exit. The Brooklyn Queens Expressway eastbound exit to the Brooklyn Bridge is closed starting as early as 30 minutes before closure hours noted below. Motorists should proceed to the following Manhattan Bridge exit or use the prior Brooklyn Battery Tunnel (pay toll) exit for access to Manhattan. All work will occur overnight during off peak hours, when Manhattan-bound motorists will be detoured to the nearby Manhattan Bridge, or may choose other crossings. The full closure for traffic proceeding Manhattan bound/westbound overnight will occur Monday night through Friday morning between 11pm and 6am, Saturday 12:01am to 7am. These lane closures are necessary to facilitate NYCDOT Bridges rehabilitation work.

BROOKLYN

- 18th Avenue between 65th Street and Bay Ridge Parkway

- 15th Avenue between Bay Ridge Parkway and 86th Street

Dispersal: Into St. Francis Cabrini Church

The above streets will be closed Friday from 8pm to 10pm for the Brooklyn West Cluster Event as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

BROOKLYN/QUEENS

<u>Grand Street over Newtown Creek</u>: This bridge will be closed Saturday 7am to 3pm until May 14, 2011 to facilitate NYCDOT bridge repairs. Motorists should use the Metropolitan Avenue Bridge as an alternate.
