East River Esplanade between 76th St and 79th Street Will Close On or About November 7, 2010

As part of the New York City Department of Transportation project to replace the East 78th Street Pedestrian Bridge over the FDR Drive, the contractor will:

Close the East River Esplanade between East 76th Street and East 79th Street.

Please refer to the map on the reverse side of this bulletin to see the approximate limits of the Esplanade closure as well as the limits of the Construction Staging Area.

The bridge at East 78th Street has been closed. To cross over the FDR Drive, please use either the bridge at East 71st Street or the bridge at East 81st Street.

The Esplanade between East 76th Street and East 78th Street will remain closed until the project is completed; the replacement bridge is expected to be opened to the public by August, 2011.
