### Reconstruction of trunk water mains along east $59^{\text{TH}}$ street

## WEEKEND STREET CLOSURE – REVISED HOURS East 59<sup>th</sup> Street between 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue

As of Saturday, October 30, 2010, and continuing on weekends for the duration of the project, the New York City Department of Design + Construction (NYCDDC) will close East 59<sup>th</sup> Street between Second Avenue and Third Avenue only during working hours. This closure is necessary to facilitate the installation of new trunk water mains on East 59<sup>th</sup> Street between First Avenue and Third Avenue. The closure will now be in effect from 7:00 AM until 5:00 PM on both Saturday and Sunday. Traffic Enforcement Agents will be stationed at critical intersections.

#### COMMUNITY IMPACTS:

- Pedestrian access to sidewalks and buildings will be maintained at all times.
- Certain pedestrian crosswalks will be closed. Please see map for specific locations. Pedestrian crosswalks will be reopened at 5:00 PM each day.
- Variable Message Signs will be placed along major roadways and local streets to alert motorists of the street closure and detour routes.
- The Q32 bus stop on East 59<sup>th</sup> Street between 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue will be closed during weekend work hours. Those who normally use this stop are advised to use the next nearest Q32 bus stop, located on East 59<sup>th</sup> Street at 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue. **Once the block is reopened at 5:00 PM each day, the bus will resume its normal route on E. 59<sup>th</sup> Street between 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue.**
- Access to the Queensboro Bridge Lower Roadway will be maintained at all times.

#### THE FOLLOWING TRAFFIC IMPACTS WILL BE IN EFFECT FROM 7:00 AM UNTIL 5:00 PM ON SATURDAY AND SUNDAY:

#### East 59th Street between 2nd Avenue and 3rd Avenue

• This block will be fully closed to through traffic. Only local and emergency traffic will be permitted. There will be **NO PARKING** on the block during this time. (See map on next page).

#### East 59th Street between the Queensboro Bridge South Outer Roadway Entrance Ramp and 2nd Avenue

• This section of East 59<sup>th</sup> Street will be closed to through traffic. Only local and emergency traffic will be permitted. (See map on next page).


### East 58th Street between 3rd Avenue and the Queensboro Bridge South Upper Roadway Entrance Ramp (located between 1st Avenue and 2nd Avenue)

• Parking will be restricted on both sides of East 58<sup>th</sup> Street to accommodate heavier traffic volumes resulting from the closure of East 59<sup>th</sup> Street between 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue. (See map on next page).

#### Access to the Queensboro Bridge Lower Roadway Entrance Ramp

- <u>South of East 59<sup>th</sup> Street:</u> Motorists wishing to access the Lower Roadway entrance ramp from East 58<sup>th</sup> Street can use the east curb lane of 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue which will be designated as a northbound contraflow lane (see map). During this time, three lanes will be maintained on 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue for southbound traffic.
- North of East 59<sup>th</sup> Street: Motorists traveling to the Lower Roadway from the north may utilize eastbound East 62<sup>nd</sup> Street to southbound 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to enter the Lower Roadway at East 59<sup>th</sup> Street.
