E. 78th Street Pedestrian Bridge Replacement Project

FDR Drive Lane Closures

Northbound, Southbound & East 79th Street Access Ramp

Starting on or about March 15, 2011, NYCDOT will implement intermittent overnight and weekend road closures on the FDR Drive in order to prepare for and complete the removal of the existing bridge and installation of the new bridge. Work will include lane stripping, installation of temporary supports and installation of traffic and construction signage.

Single lane closures will begin at 11 p.m. and become two lane closures at 1 a.m. All lanes will be re-opened to traffic at 5 a.m. There will also be intermittent day-time closures on the entrance ramp to the Southbound FDR Drive at E. 79th Street. This work will continue over the next several months and additional notices of specific scheduled closures will be provided.

FDR Drive - One lane closures

11 p.m. through 1 a.m.

Northbound from E.72nd St. to E.81st St. / Southbound from E.85th St. to E.77th St.

FDR Drive - Two lane closures

1 a.m. through 5 a.m.

Northbound from E.68th St. to E.81st St. / Southbound from E.89th St. to E.77th St.

FDR Service Road from East E.79th Street to the Southbound FDR Drive

Full closure from 11:00 a.m. through 2:00 p.m.
