

- Connect to 3<sup>rd</sup> Water Tunnel Shaft 33B
- New trunk and distribution water mains connecting. Including:
  - o 48" & 36" trunk mains
  - o 20" & 12" distribution mains
  - o Valves, regulators & chambers

- Various utility infrastructure
- Catch basins and connections
- Pedestrian Ramps
- New Roadway Surface









### **COMMUNITY IMPACTS**

### Office of Community Outreach & Notification

- Pedestrian access to buildings will be maintained at all times.
- Street closures and /or limited access may be necessary.
- Uniformed NYPD Traffic Agents assigned for traffic control.
- Certain operations will be noisy; DDC will monitor operations and work within DEP Noise Code regulations.



# **COMMUNITY IMPACTS (Cont'd)**

### Office of Community Outreach & Notification

- □ Driveway/loading dock access may be temporarily restricted while a street is closed to through-traffic (coordination will be arranged on a case by case basis).
- Parking may be temporarily restricted
  - Signs will be posted where necessary and advance notification provided.



# **COMMUNITY IMPACTS (Cont'd)**

## **Water Service Interruptions:**

- Water service disruptions will be necessary
- Prior day advance notice will be provided
- ☐ Specific instructions will be provided prior to water shutoff
- ☐ If your water service is not restored within 3 hours of the time indicated on the Shutoff Notice, please contact the Community Construction Liaison (CCL) or 311 if after hours.

### **Special Needs:**

- Individuals with special needs should contact the CCL
- DDC field staff will work specifically with those individuals to minimize the inconvenience

- Rodent Control Stations will be installed by a professional rodent control contractor


