

WEEKEND TRAFFIC ADVISORY Friday, October 15, 2010 to Sunday, October 17, 2010

As part of its citywide traffic improvement program, the New York City Department of Transportation has compiled a list of areas where Street construction or Street events will impede the normal flow of traffic this weekend.

MANHATTAN

<u>FDR Drive at East 6th Street, East 25th Street, East 51st Street Pedestrian Bridge Overpasses</u>: One of three lanes in each direction may be closed Sunday from 1am to 11am at the above noted locations to facilitate NYCDOT bridge inspection work.

<u>West 13th Street between 9th Avenue and 10th Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 6am to 1pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>East 16th Street between Irving Place and Third Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 16th Street between 8th Avenue and 9th Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 25th Street between 7th Avenue and 8th Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 7am to 7pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>East 30th Street between 1st Avenue and FDR Service Road</u>: This street will be closed from 10pm Friday to 10pm Sunday to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 32nd Street between 5th Avenue and Broadway</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 35th Street between 8th Avenue and 9th Avenue</u>: This street will be closed 6am to 9pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 45th Street between Madison Avenue and Lexington Avenue; Vanderbilt Avenue between East 46th Street and East 44th Street; Park Avenue southbound between East 46th Street and East 42nd Street: These streets may be closed (weather permitting) from 7am to 11pm Saturday to facilitate East Side Access structural work.

<u>East 50th Street between Madison Avenue and Park Avenue</u>: This street will be closed 8pm Friday to 5am Monday to facilitate crane operation for MTA East Side Access project. <u>West 53rd Street between 11th Avenue and 10th Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 56th Street between 6thAvenue and 5th Avenue</u>: This street will be closed from 8am to 4pm Saturday and/or Sunday to facilitate crane operation for NYC Sanitation Department building.

<u>West 56th Street between 11th Avenue and 12th Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation for Sanitation Garage Building.

<u>East 65th Street between Madison Avenue and Park Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>East 87th Street between Madison Avenue and Park Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 3pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 151st Street between Riverside Drive and Broadway</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 3pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Mercer Street between Spring Street and Prince Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Carmine Street between Varick Street and Bedford Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Barrow Street between Bedford Street and 7th Avenue South</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Greene Street between Broome Street and Spring Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Minetta Street between Bleecker Street and Minetta Lane</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Gold Street between Fulton Street and Ryders Alley</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 6pm and Sunday from 9am to 6pm to facilitate sewer operation.

<u>Broadway between West 47th Street and West 48th Street</u>: This street will be closed 12:01am to 10am Sunday to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Broadway between Reade Street and Chambers Street</u>: One lane southbound on Broadway will be maintained Saturday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

Nassau Street between Ann Street and Fulton Street; Ann Street between Park Row and <u>Williams Street; including intersection of Ann Street at Nassau Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate NYCDDC roadway work.

<u>Washington Street between Albany Street and Cedar Street</u>: This street will be closed daily from 7am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Thames Street between Greenwich Street and Trinity Place</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 10pm to facilitate Con Ed roadway work.

<u>Stone Street between Hanover Square and Coenties Alley; Mill Lane between Stone Street</u> <u>and South Williams Street</u>: These streets will be closed daily from 10am to 11pm April 1 through November 30th for the Stone Street Pedestrian Mall as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

<u>3rd Avenue between East 23rd Street and East 34th Street</u>: This street will be closed Sunday from 11am to 6pm for the St. Stephen-Our Lady of Scapular-3rd Avenue Fair as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

<u>Formation</u>: 51st Street between 5th Avenue and 6th Avenue <u>Route</u>: 51st Street between 6th Avenue and 9th Avenue <u>Dispersal</u>: 51st Street between 9th Avenue 10th Avenue The above streets will be closed Sunday from 3:30pm to 8pm for the Brotherhood of Our Lord of Miracles Celebration as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

MANHATTAN/BROOKLYN

<u>Williamsburg Bridge</u>: On Saturday from 5:30am to 3:30pm there will be four lanes westbound/Manhattan bound and two lanes eastbound/Brooklyn bound to facilitate NYCDOT Bridges/FDNY testing of the standpipe system.

BROOKLYN

<u>Ft. Greene Place between Hanson Place and Fulton Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>South Elliot Place between Hanson Place and Fulton Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Carroll Street between Van Brunt Street and Columbia Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.
