



WEEKEND TRAFFIC ADVISORY
Friday, October 15, 2010 to Sunday, October 17, 2010

As part of its citywide traffic improvement program, the New York City Department of Transportation has compiled a list of areas where Street construction or Street events will impede the normal flow of traffic this weekend.

MANHATTAN

FDR Drive at East 6th Street, East 25th Street, East 51st Street Pedestrian Bridge Overpasses: One of three lanes in each direction may be closed Sunday from 1am to 11am at the above noted locations to facilitate NYCDOT bridge inspection work.

West 13th Street between 9th Avenue and 10th Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 6am to 1pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 16th Street between Irving Place and Third Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 16th Street between 8th Avenue and 9th Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 25th Street between 7th Avenue and 8th Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday from 7am to 7pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 30th Street between 1st Avenue and FDR Service Road: This street will be closed from 10pm Friday to 10pm Sunday to facilitate crane operation.

West 32nd Street between 5th Avenue and Broadway: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 35th Street between 8th Avenue and 9th Avenue: This street will be closed 6am to 9pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 45th Street between Madison Avenue and Lexington Avenue; Vanderbilt Avenue between East 46th Street and East 44th Street; Park Avenue southbound between East 46th Street and East 42nd Street: These streets may be closed (weather permitting) from 7am to 11pm Saturday to facilitate East Side Access structural work.

East 50th Street between Madison Avenue and Park Avenue: This street will be closed 8pm Friday to 5am Monday to facilitate crane operation for MTA East Side Access project.

West 53rd Street between 11th Avenue and 10th Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 56th Street between 6th Avenue and 5th Avenue: This street will be closed from 8am to 4pm Saturday and/or Sunday to facilitate crane operation for NYC Sanitation Department building.

West 56th Street between 11th Avenue and 12th Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation for Sanitation Garage Building.

East 65th Street between Madison Avenue and Park Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 87th Street between Madison Avenue and Park Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 3pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 151st Street between Riverside Drive and Broadway: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 3pm to facilitate crane operation.

Mercer Street between Spring Street and Prince Street: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

Carmine Street between Varick Street and Bedford Street: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

Barrow Street between Bedford Street and 7th Avenue South: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

Greene Street between Broome Street and Spring Street: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

Minetta Street between Bleecker Street and Minetta Lane: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

Gold Street between Fulton Street and Ryders Alley: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 6pm and Sunday from 9am to 6pm to facilitate sewer operation.

Broadway between West 47th Street and West 48th Street: This street will be closed 12:01am to 10am Sunday to facilitate crane operation.

Broadway between Reade Street and Chambers Street: One lane southbound on Broadway will be maintained Saturday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

Nassau Street between Ann Street and Fulton Street; Ann Street between Park Row and Williams Street; including intersection of Ann Street at Nassau Street: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate NYCDDC roadway work.

Washington Street between Albany Street and Cedar Street: This street will be closed daily from 7am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

Thames Street between Greenwich Street and Trinity Place: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 10pm to facilitate Con Ed roadway work.

Stone Street between Hanover Square and Coenties Alley; Mill Lane between Stone Street and South Williams Street: These streets will be closed daily from 10am to 11pm April 1 through November 30th for the Stone Street Pedestrian Mall as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

3rd Avenue between East 23rd Street and East 34th Street: This street will be closed Sunday from 11am to 6pm for the St. Stephen-Our Lady of Scapular-3rd Avenue Fair as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

Formation: 51st Street between 5th Avenue and 6th Avenue

Route: 51st Street between 6th Avenue and 9th Avenue

Dispersal: 51st Street between 9th Avenue 10th Avenue

The above streets will be closed Sunday from 3:30pm to 8pm for the Brotherhood of Our Lord of Miracles Celebration as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

MANHATTAN/BROOKLYN

Williamsburg Bridge: On Saturday from 5:30am to 3:30pm there will be four lanes westbound/Manhattan bound and two lanes eastbound/Brooklyn bound to facilitate NYCDOT Bridges/FDNY testing of the standpipe system.

BROOKLYN

Ft. Greene Place between Hanson Place and Fulton Street: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

South Elliot Place between Hanson Place and Fulton Street: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

Carroll Street between Van Brunt Street and Columbia Street: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.
