

### **COLUMBUS DAY WEEKEND TRAFFIC ADVISORY Friday, October 8, 2010 to Monday, October 11, 2010**

As part of its citywide traffic improvement program, the New York City Department of Transportation has compiled a list of areas where Street construction or Street events will impede the normal flow of traffic this weekend.

# **MANHATTAN**

<u>West 3<sup>rd</sup> Street between LaGuardia Street and Mercer Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 7am to 2pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 13<sup>th</sup> Street between 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Washington Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 6am to 1pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>East 21<sup>st</sup> Street between Gramercy Park East and Third Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 9am to 5pm to facilitate crane operation.
