	Food Cart Size and Orientation Restrictions	Food cart may not exceed 5' (five) FEET in width and 10' (ten) FEET in length, including cart attachments & overhangs.	RCNY s 6-06
23	Food Cart Size and Orientation Restrictions	Food cart operating on the sidewalk must place the food cart so that the longer side is adjacent and parallel to the curb abutting the sidewalk.	RCNY S 6-06
A	FOOD CART LOCATION	Food cart must be set up no further than 18" (eighteen) INCHES from the curb on the sidewalk.	AC S 17-315 (a)
A	FOOD CART LOCATION	Food cart must be at least 10' (ten) FEET from a crosswalk or subway entrance/exit	AC S 17-315 (e)

	FOOD CART LOCATION	Food cart may not lean against or touch a building or structure (e.g. scaffolding, telephone booth, fire hydrant, lamp posts, parking meters, etc.)	AC S 17-315 (b)

	Amplified Sound	It is unlawful to operate any device or apparatus for the amplification of sound in a public area without first obtaining a permit from the NYPD	AC S 10-108
	MOBILE FOOD TRUCK VENDING	Each mobile food truck must be operated by a person with a valid food vendor's license and the mobile food truck must have a valid permit.	RCNY s 6-01 & AC S 17-307
	MOBILE FOOD TRUCK VENDING	Mobile food truck may not display, sell, or offer merchandise for sale from a vehicle within a metered parking space while parking meter regulations are in effect.	RCNY S 4-08 (h) (-8)

	Required license	General vendor must surrender the license when asked to do so by a Police Officer or other authorized City employee	AC S 20-461 (a)
	Vending Stand Size & Orientation Restrictions	General vendor's stand may not exceed 8' eight in width parallel to the curb and 3' three FEET in depth.	AC S 20-465 (b)
	General vendor's display height	Including the stand, may not exceed five (5') FEET in height measured from the ground level.	AC S 20-465 (n)
	General vendor Stand Location	It must be set up no further than (18") eighteen inches from the curb on the sidewalk.	AC S 20-465 (a)
	General vendor's stand	It must be at least ten (10') FEET from any driveway, subway entrance or exit, or any corner	AC S 20-465 (e)
	General vendor's stand Location	It must be at (20') twenty FEET from the entrance a building, store, or other place of public assembly as measured by the edge of the stand to the center of the doorway.	AC S 20-465 (d)
	General vendor's stand Location	It may not be located in a bus stop or taxi stand.	AC S 20-465 (e)
	General vendor's stand sidewalk	It may not be placed on a sidewalk that is than 12' twelve FEET wide as measured from the boundary of private property to the curb.	AC S 20-465 (a)
	General vendor's stand	It may not lean against or touch a building or structure (E.G. scaffolding, telephone booth, fire hydrant, lamp posts, parking meters, etc.)	AC S 20-465 (c)
	General vendor	He shall only use the area immediately beneath the surface of the display space for the storage of items for sale.	AC S 10-465 (n)
	General vendor's stand	It must not be placed over a utility structure such as: ventilation grill, cellar door, manhole, transformer vault, or subway access grate.	AC S 20-465 (m)
	General vendor's stand	It must be at least five (5') FEET from a bus shelter, newstand, public telephone, or disable access ramp	AC S 20-465 (q)
	Amplified Sound	It is unlawful to operate any apparatus for the amplification of a sound in a public area without first obtaining a permit from the NYPD.	AC S 10-108
	Generator or Electricity	No vendor shall use electricity, electrical equipment or oil or gasoline powered equipment of any kind.	AC S 20-465 (p)
NOTE: "A" violations mean violations of the following provisions of subchapter 2 ("Food Vendors") of chapter 3 ("Licenses and Permits") of title 17 of the Administrative Code or successor provisions, as listed above , where the licensee, permittee or applicant is found in violaiton as a result of a hearing on the merits or by default.
