

<u>WEEKEND TRAFFIC ADVISORY</u> Friday, September 17, 2010 to Sunday, September 19, 2010

As part of its citywide traffic improvement program, the New York City Department of Transportation has compiled a list of areas where Street construction or Street events will impede the normal flow of traffic this weekend.

MANHATTAN

<u>East 11th Street between 5th Avenue and University Place</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 13th Street between 9th Avenue and Washington Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 6am to 1pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>East 17th Street between 2nd Avenue and 1st Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 17th Street between 8th Avenue and 7th Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 19th Street between 7th Avenue and 6th Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 27th Street between 10th Avenue and 11th Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>East 28th Street between Lexington Avenue and 3rd Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 29th Street between 8th Avenue and 7th Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 35th Street between 6th Avenue and 5th Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 45th Street between 10th Avenue and 9th Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 56th Street between 6thAvenue and 5th Avenue</u>: This street will be closed from 8am to 4pm Saturday and/or Sunday to facilitate crane operation.

East 56th Street between 2nd Avenue and 3rd Avenue: This street will be closed from 6am to 9pm Saturday and/or Sunday to facilitate crane assembly operation.

<u>West 73rd Street between Amsterdam Avenue and Columbus Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 3pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 93rd Street between Riverside Drive and West End Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 153rd between Riverside Drive and Broadway</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 179th Street between Audubon Avenue and Amsterdam Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 2pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>FDR Drive Southbound vicinity of East 70th Street</u>: The FDR southbound service road entrance ramp at East 70th Street will be closed Saturday from 12:01am to 6:30am and Sunday 1am to 11am to facilitate building façade repairs by private contractor. Southbound traffic wishing to enter the FDR Drive from East 73rd Street and York Avenue should continue south and re-enter the FDR Drive at East 61st Street.

<u>Nathan D. Pearlman Place between East 16th Street and East 17th Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Reade Street between Church Street and Broadway</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 6am to 9pm to facilitate crane assembly operation.

<u>Willet Street between Grand Street and Delancey Street South</u>: This street will be closed Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Stone Street between Hanover Square and Coenties Alley; Mill Lane between Stone Street</u> <u>and South Williams Street</u>: These streets will be closed daily from 10am to 11pm April 1 through November 30th for the Stone Street Pedestrian Mall as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

<u>Murray Street between Broadway and Church Street</u>: This street will be closed Friday from 11am to 6pm for the 1st Precinct Block Party as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

<u>Broadway between West 47th Street and West 57th Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 11am to 6pm for the Guardian Angels Street Festival as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

<u>8th Avenue between West 42nd Street and West 57th Street</u>: This street will be closed Sunday from 11am to 6pm for the 47th Street Block Association Street Festival as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

<u>Columbus Avenue between West 66th Street and West 86th Street</u>: This street will be close Sunday from 11am to 6pm for the West Manhattan Chamber of Commerce Street Festival as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO). <u>Formation</u>: 37th Street and 38th Street between 5th Avenue and Park Avenue <u>Route</u>: Madison Avenue between 38th Street and 27th Street <u>Dispersal</u>: 27th Street between Park Avenue and 5th Avenue The above streets will be closed Sunday from 11am to 4pm for the Mexican Day Parade as permitted by NYPD.

<u>Formation</u>: Adam Clayton Powell Boulevard between 110th Street and 136th Street/ 136th Street between Adam Clayton Powell Boulevard and 5th Avenue <u>Dispersal</u>: 136th Street and 5th Avenue The above streets will be closed Sunday from 11am to 6pmn for the 41st Annual African American Day Parade as permitted by NYPD.

<u>Mulberry Street between Canal Street and East Houston Street; Gran Street between Mott</u> <u>Street and Centre Street; Hester Street between Mott Street and Centre Street</u>: These streets will be closed 11am to 11pm daily from September 16th, 2010 through September 26, 2010 for the Figil Di San Gennaro Festivals as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

<u>Hudson Street between Franklin Street and Laight Street</u>: This street will be narrowed to two lanes of traffic (with no access to the Holland Tunnel) to facilitate NYCDDC trunk watermain work starting Sunday September 19, 2010 through 2015. The following traffic pattern changes will be in effect:

-No access to the Holland Tunnel from Hudson Street (at Canal Street) for the duration of the project. Westbound and Eastbound motorists on Canal Street will still be able to enter the Holland Tunnel. Motorists on Hudson Street will not be permitted to enter the Holland Tunnel at Canal Street. Northbound motorists on West Street will be permitted to turn right onto Canal Street to access Holland Tunnel at all times.

<u>Chambers Street between West Broadway and West Street (Route 9A)</u>: This street was converted from two-way to a one-way westbound operation on August 29, 2010 until Spring of 2012 to facilitate major water and sewer utility work and roadway reconstruction by NYCDDC.

MANHATTAN/BROOKLYN

Brooklyn Bridge: This Bridge is closed to Manhattan-bound traffic overnight as of Monday night August 23rd 2010 to perform necessary long term rehabilitation and repainting work. Brooklyn-bound traffic will be maintained throughout the project as will the span's pedestrian and cycling path. Motorists should follow signed routes to access the bridge leaving Manhattan. The northbound FDR exit to the Brooklyn Bridge is closed starting 30 minutes before closure hours noted below. Motorists should use the prior South Street exit. All work will occur overnight during off peak hours, when Manhattan-bound motorists will be detoured to the nearby Manhattan Bridge, or may choose other crossings. The full closure Manhattan bound/westbound overnight closures will occur Thursday night 11pm until Friday morning 6am and again Saturday 12:01am to 7am.

BROOKLYN

<u>Tiffany Place between Degraw Street and Kane Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Carroll Street between Albany Avenue and Troy Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Joralemon Street between Clinton Street and Court Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Myrtle Avenue between Clermont Avenue and Grand Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Sunday September 19, 26 from 11am to 6pm on September 19, 26 for the DOT Weekend Walks Move About Myrtle as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

<u>Pitkin Avenue between Strauss and Thomas Boyland Streets</u>: This street will be closed Sunday September 19, 26 from 11am to 6pm for the DOT Weekend Walks-Pitkin Summer Plaza as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

<u>Montague Street between Clinton and Hick Streets</u>: This street will be closed Sunday September 19, 26 from 11am to 6pm for the DOT Weekend Walks-Summer Space as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

<u>Gowanus Expressway outbound/southbound exit to Prospect Expressway</u>: This exit will be closed from 11pm Friday through 5am Saturday to facilitate NYSDOT construction activity. Motorists should use the prior Hamilton Avenue exit or the next 39th Street exit.

QUEENS

<u>Beach 22nd Street between Mott Avenue and Loretta Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 7am to 7pm to facilitate NYCT crane operation.

<u>Woodside Avenue between Roosevelt Avenue and 65th Place</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 11am to 6pm for the Woodside on the Move-Woodside Avenue Festival as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).
