

WEEKEND TRAFFIC ADVISORY Friday, September 24, 2010 to Sunday, September 26, 2010

As part of its citywide traffic improvement program, the New York City Department of Transportation has compiled a list of areas where Street construction or Street events will impede the normal flow of traffic this weekend.

MANHATTAN

West 13th Street between 9th Avenue and Washington Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 6am to 1pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 26th Street between Lexington Avenue and 3rd Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 27^{th} Street between 11^{th} Avenue and 12^{th} Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>West 29th Street between 7th Avenue and 8th Avenue</u>: This street will be closed 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 55^{th} Street between 6^{th} Avenue and 5^{th} Avenue: This street will be closed from 8am to 4pm Saturday and/or Sunday to facilitate crane operation.

 $\underline{\text{West } 62^{\text{nd}} \text{ Street between Broadway and Central Park West}}$: This street will be closed from 8am to 6pm Saturday and/or Sunday to facilitate crane assembly operation.

West 65th Street between Amsterdam Avenue and Broadway: This street will be closed from 10pm Friday until 6am Monday to facilitate crane operation.

East 69th Street between 3rd Avenue and 2nd Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 70th Street between 3rd Avenue and 2nd Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 9am to 7pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 73rd Street between Amsterdam Avenue and Columbus Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 3pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 75th Street between 3rd Avenue and 2nd Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 3pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>East 77th Street between Madison Avenue and Park Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 3pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>East 83rd Street between York Avenue and East End Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 3pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>East 98th Street between 5th Avenue and Madison Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 3pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>East 102nd Street between Lexington Avenue and Third Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>East 119th Street between Lexington Avenue and 3rd Avenue</u>: This street will be closed Saturday 6am to Sunday 9pm to facilitate crane removal operation.

West 144th Street between Frederick Douglas Boulevard and Adam Clayton Powell Boulevard: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 162nd Street between Riverside Drive and Fort Washington Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 3pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Suffolk Street between Stanton Street and East Houston Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Elizabeth Street between Canal Street and Hester Street</u>: This street will be closed 1am to 7am Saturday and/or Sunday to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Suffolk Street between Delancey Street and Rivington Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Sullivan Street between Broome Street and Spring Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Clinton Street between Rivington Street and Stanton Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Charlton Street between Hudson Street and Varick Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Riverside Drive Service Road between West 161st Street and West 162nd Street:</u> This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 2pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Hudson Street between Franklin Street and Laight Street</u>: This street was narrowed to two lanes of traffic (with no access to the Holland Tunnel) to facilitate NYCDDC trunk watermain work as of Sunday September 19, 2010 through 2015. The following traffic pattern changes will be in effect:

-No access to the Holland Tunnel from Hudson Street (at Canal Street) for the duration of the project. Westbound and Eastbound motorists on Canal Street will still be able to enter the Holland Tunnel. Motorists on Hudson Street will not be permitted to enter the Holland Tunnel at Canal Street. Northbound motorists on West Street will be permitted to turn right onto Canal Street to access Holland Tunnel at all times.

<u>Chambers Street between West Broadway and West Street (Route 9A)</u>: This street was converted from two-way to a one-way westbound operation on August 29, 2010 until Spring of 2012 to facilitate major water and sewer utility work and roadway reconstruction by NYCDDC.

<u>Spruce Street between William Street and Gold Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday form 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Albany Street between Washington Street and Greenwich Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 6pm and Sunday from 9am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Albany Street between Washington Street and West Street</u>: This street will be closed Friday night and Saturday night from 10pm to 6am to facilitate crane operation.

<u>Reade Street between Broadway and Church Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 6pm and Sunday from 9am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

1st Avenue to 3rd Avenue between East 47th Street and East 42nd Street; East 42nd East 42nd Street between 1st Avenue and 3rd Avenue: These streets are subject to intermittent closures for the UN General Assembly throughout the weekend.

Stone Street between Hanover Square and Coenties Alley; Mill Lane between Stone Street and South Williams Street: These streets will be closed daily from 10am to 11pm April 1 through November 30th for the Stone Street Pedestrian Mall as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

<u>Mulberry Street between Canal Street and East Houston Street; Gran Street between Mott Street and Centre Street; Hester Street between Mott Street and Centre Street:</u> These streets will be closed 11am to 11pm daily from September 16th, 2010 through September 26, 2010 for the Figil Di San Gennaro Festivals as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

Formation: 67th Street to 70th Street between 5th Avenue and Lexington Avenue

Route: 5th Avenue between 67th Street and 86th Street

Dispersal: 5th Avenue and 86th Street

The above streets will be closed Saturday from 11am to 5pm for the German American Comm. of Greater NY Parade as permitted by NYPD.

<u>Broadway between Waverly Place and 14th Street</u>: This street will be closed Saturday from 11am to 6pm for the C.O.R.E. Autumn Fair as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

6th Avenue between West 42nd Street and West 56th Street: This street will be closed Saturday from 11am to 6pm for the International Gospel Uptown as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

5th Avenue between 80th Street and 59th Street: This street will be closed Sunday from 7am to 3pm for the Continental Airlines 5th Avenue Mile as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

<u>Lexington Avenue between East 79th Street and East 96th Street:</u> This street will be closed Sunday from 11am to 6pm for the 92nd Street "Y"Lexington Avenue Festival as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

<u>Lexington Avenue between East 34th Street and East 42nd Street:</u> This street will be closed Sunday from 11am to 6pm for the Soldiers, Sailors, Marines, Airmen's Club Lexington Avenue Fall Festival as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

Formation: 36th Street and 37th Street between Park Avenue and 5th Avenues; Madison

Avenue between 36th Street and 38th Street

Route: Madison Avenue between 36th Street and 25th Street

Dispersal: 25th Street between Madison Avenue and Park Avenue

Festival: Madison Avenue between 26th Street and 23rd Street

The above streets will be closed Sunday from 1:15pm to 3:30pm for the Muslim Day Parade and Festival as permitted by NYPD.

MANHATTAN/BROOKLYN

Worth Street between St. James and Broadway; Centre Street between Worth Street and Park Row; Brooklyn Bridge Boulevard between Tillary Street and Johnson Street: These streets will be closed intermittently Saturday from 9:30am to 3pm for the National Council for Alcoholism and Drug Dependency Demolition as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

Formation: Hamilton Avenue and Henry Street

<u>Route</u>: Hamilton Avenue from Henry Street to Columbia Street through tunnel to Manhattan; West Side Highway between Joseph P. Ward Street and Liberty Street; Liberty Street between West Street and South End Avenue; Vesey Street between North End Avenues and West Street

The above streets will be closed Sunday from 9:30am to 3pm for the Stephen Siller Tunnel to Towers Run and Festival as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

BROOKLYN

<u>Gowanus Expressway outbound/southbound exit to Prospect Expressway</u>: This exit will be closed from 11pm Friday through 5am Saturday to facilitate NYSDOT construction activity. Motorists should use the prior Hamilton Avenue exit or the next 39th Street exit.

Myrtle Avenue between Clermont Avenue and Grand Avenue: This street will be closed Sunday September 19, 26 from 11am to 6pm on September 26 for the DOT Weekend Walks Move About Myrtle as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

<u>Pitkin Avenue between Strauss and Thomas Boyland Streets</u>: This street will be closed Sunday September 26 from 11am to 6pm for the DOT Weekend Walks-Pitkin Summer Plaza as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).
