- 1. Public Hearing re: Applications for Single-block Street Fairs for Calendar Year 2016
- a. German American Committee of Greater New York to close East 60<sup>th</sup> Street between Madison and Fifth Avenues on Saturday, May 14, 2016 from 12PM to 5:00PM for a block festival.

This event will be held in conjunction with the Steuben Day Parade. The presenters discussed the long history of the Organization in our community. Money raised will go to scholarships for students in our community, for permits to operate the Parade, for educational programs and to the Central Park Conservancy.

There will be 50 vendors. Booths will highlight German Culture and food. Local German restaurants will be encouraged to participate. There will be no amplified music. This is a new event.
