

Re: A request for a new Revocable Consent at 69 East 82nd Street for a fenced-in area

Dear Commissioner Forgione:

At the May 16, 2012 Full Board meeting, Community Board 8M **APPROVED** the following resolution by a vote of 38 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstentions and 0 not voting for cause:

WHEREAS the townhouse located at 69 East 82nd Street is the only one of a row of eleven adjacent townhouses that does not have a fence and garden in front of its entrance;

WHEREAS the townhouse owner is requesting to install a fence three feet in height, extending five feet from the lot line, creating a consistent fence line with the ten adjacent townhouses;

WHEREAS there will be six feet four inches of clearance between the fence and the tree pit located in front of the property; and

WHEREAS 69 East 82nd Street is not an individual landmark and is not located within the boundaries of a designated historic district;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Community Board 8M approves the request for this new Revocable Consent.
