At the May 22, 2013 Full Board meeting of Manhattan Community Board 8, the following resolution regarding electronically generated tickets for vendor infractions.

WHEREAS, tickets issued to vendors are often dismissed because they are incorrectly written, WHEREAS, the Vendor Task Force Committee and others have received numerous complaints from the 19th Precinct expressing frustration that tickets are dismissed because they are incorrectly written.

WHEREAS, a ticket will now have a space for both the vendor license number and the cart permit number because of newly enacted legislation by the City Council, and WHEREAS, these tickets will now have to be re-designed to accommodate this new requirement, and

WHEREAS, there is precedent for electronically generated tickets,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Community Board 8 strongly supports electronically generated tickets for vendor infractions.

This recommendation was approved by a vote of 31 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstentions.
