WHEREAS the applicant was made aware of these issues and agreed to remedy per the stipulations listed below

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the application is approved subject to the following stipulations which were agreed to by the applicant and are to be incorporated in the license's method of operation:

• The hours of operation for the SLA license will be:

Monday to Thursday – 5:00pm to Midnight Friday – 5:00pm to 2:00am Saturday – 11:00am to 2:00am Sunday – 11:00am to Midnight

- The front windows and doors will be closed by 10pm every day
- The rear yard will not be used after 10pm on Sunday through Thursday or after 10:30pm on Friday and Saturday
- The level of recorded music will be kept to a low, non-intrusive level
- The table and chairs in the Sidewalk Café will be laid out according to the plans approved by the Department of Consumer Affairs at all times.
