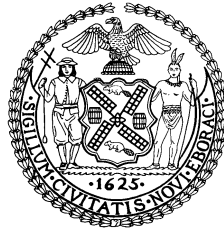

- Founded in 1881, The Knickerbocker Greys is an after-school activity for boys and girls ages 6-16.
 - Cadets undergo a series of experiences over the years that build confidence, improve self-esteem, character development, etiquette and social skills, patience and empathy, perseverance and enthusiasm, public speaking and leadership.
 - The name is derived from the color of the uniform and knee-length pants.
 - In the first year there were 12 boys, currently there are 30 girls and boys.
 - Girls were admitted in 1986.
 - Cadets join the Greys through word-of-mouth.
 - Ribbons and medals are distributed in the spring and during holiday review.
 - Weekly drills take place every Tuesday at the Park Avenue Armory on Park Avenue and 66th Street.
