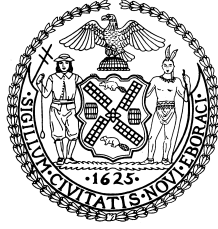

1. Continuing conversation with representatives from Ocean Recovery East inpatient addiction recovery program. Ocean Recovery East to begin operation at the 113 East 60 Street location.

Representatives from Ocean Recovery East returned to the Health, Seniors and Social Services Committee to readdress neighbors' concerns about their facility. They have developed a program for a medically supervised withdrawal facility, serving financially high end clients who are addicted to prescription medications. After hearing neighbors' concerns at the September 22, 2016 Health, Seniors and Social Services Committee meeting they promised to address the concerns.

- No signage on the buildings
- The facility is limited to 18 beds
- Will consider awarding scholarships to those who cannot afford their services
- Provide 24-hour security and car service for clients leaving the facility
- Screen clients to make certain the population is appropriate

WHEREAS Community Board 8M passed the resolution to approve Ocean Recovery East's program, as long as the representatives returned when a location was selected and

WHEREAS the facility has selected a location that will not impact the neighborhood negatively; and
