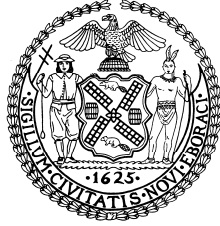

One issue that was raised by several people was the matter emergency evacuation of the subway passengers in the event of another event like Superstorm Sandy. The concern was that it would be difficult enough for able-bodied people to climb the 80-90 feet to the surface but impossible for the disabled to do so. The question was how was the MTA prepared to deal with a wide-spread power outage that crippled elevators and escalators during Hurricane Sandy. Mr. Goodrich stated that he would respond to the Community Board no later than February 1<sup>st</sup> with a written reply.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:40 pm.
