Meeting called to order at 7:15PM by Hedi White and Barbara Chocky

- 1. Public Hearings re: Applications for Multi-Block Street Fairs for Calendar Year 2013
- A. Museum Mile- Application to close Fifth Avenue from 82nd street to 109th street on Tuesday June 11th, from 6:00pm to 9:00pm to hold a Street Festival.

This will be the 35th year of the Festival where all the museums on Fifth Avenue participate.

During discussion the Public and Board Members spoke about how much they enjoyed this festival.

Motion to Approve—Passed 3-0-0 – Yes Viest, White, Chocky

B. Brick Presbyterian Church- Application to close Park Avenue from 90th to 93rd Streets from 5:00PM to 8:00PM for a religious ceremony.

This event started in 1946. During the event the Christmas trees are lit on Park Avenue.

Motion to Approve: Passed 4-0-0. Yes Viest, White, Birnbaum, Chocky.

C. Application by the Parents Association of P.S. 183 to close the sidewalk on the south side of East 67th Street between York and First Avenues for parking and vendors and sidewalk on the north side of 66th street from York and First Avenues, from Saturday January 5, 2013 to Saturday December 28. 2013 from 6:00AM to 5:00PM for a flea market.

Motion to Approve: Passed 4-0-0 Yes Viest, White, Birnbaum, Chocky

D. Application by the 19th Precinct Council to close Lexington Avenue from 60th and 66th Streets on Saturday May 4th, from 12:00 PM to 5:00PM for a Street Festival.

Funds from this event are used to support the community. Motion to approve: Passed 3-0-0-1-Yes White, Birnbaum, Chocky. Not voting for cause Viest.

E. Application by Lenox Neighborhood House to close First Avenue from 68th to 79th Streets on Saturday June 8th from 12:00PM to 5:00pm for a Street Festival.

The funds from this event are used to support their programs. Motion to approve: Passed 3-0-0-1 Yes Viest, Birnbaum, Chocky. Not Voting for Cause White.

F. And G. It was decided to hear these two items together.

Applications by the Manhattan Chamber of Commerce to close East 66th to East 86th Streets on Third Avenue on Sunday June 2nd and on Sunday September 8th from 12:00 to 5:00 PM for Street Festivals.

On June 2nd it will be the Second Avenue Festival which cannot be held on Second Avenue because of the subway construction. Merchants on Second Avenue will be given priority for space at the June Festival.

H. Application by the French Institute/Alliance Française to close East 60th Street between Fifth and Lexington Avenues, on Sunday July 14th from 12:00pm to 5:00pm for a Street Festival.

I. Application by the East 60th Street Neighborhood Association to close East 60th Street between Fifth and Madison Avenues on Sunday August 4th from 12:00pm to 5:00pm.

One of the Bd. member expressed concern that the Association is a 501C4 and that we should consider only approving application by 501C3 organizations.

J. Application by the 92nd Street Y to close 79th to 96th Streets on Lexington Avenue on Sunday September 15th from 12:00 to 5:00PM for a Street Festival

The funds from this event would be used for programs at the Y. Many of these programs will have displays and demonstrations at the Festival. Motion to approve: Passed 4-0-0 Yes Viest, White, Birnbaum, Chocky

K. Review of the Greenmarket located on the South side of 82nd Street between First and York Avenues on Saturdays from January 5th to Saturday December 28th from 8:00am to 5:00pm for a Green Market. (every Saturday)

A member of the Board was concerned about congestion and difficulty during the winter when there is snow on the street.

L. Review of the Greenmarket located on the East side of First Avenue between 92nd and 93rd Streets on Sundays from June 23rd to November 24th This is one month shorter than this year.

Motion to Approve: Passed 4-0-0 Yes Viest, White, Birnbaum, Chocky

M. Application by The Gracie Square Art Show to close East End Avenue from 84th to 88th Streets on Saturday October 5th and Sunday October 6th from 11:00am to 5:00pm for an Art Festival

Motion to Approve: Passed 4-0-0 Yes Viest, White, Birnbaum, Chocky.

Please note it was decided that the application by Prime Butcher Baker to close an East Curb Lane on Second Avenue should not be heard by The Street Fairs Committee. Nick Viest the Chair of the Bd. will refer it to the Transportation Committee.

- 2. Public Hearings re: Applications for single block Street Fairs for Calendar Year 2013.
- A. Application by The Convent of Sacred Heart to close East 91st Street between Fifth and Madison Avenues on Thursday June 6th from 12:00pm to 3:00pm for a block party.

There was no one present from the School, so application was laid over.

B. Application by the Dalton School to close East 91st Street between Park and Lexington Avenues on Friday May 24th from 11:30 to 2:30 for a block party. They have been holding this event for at least 10 years. The Community is invited.
