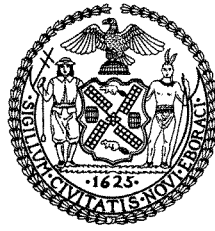

Dear Chair Tierney:

At the Full Board meeting on Wednesday, November 20, 2013, the board adopted the following resolution regarding **19 East 79th Street (between Fifth and Madison Avenues) – Metropolitan Museum Historic District – Matthew Haberling, Architect** – A neo-Grec style townhouse built in 1880 and designed by D. & J. Jardine, with alterations by Herts & Tallant completed in 1902. Application is to reconstruct existing rooftop sunroom.

WHEREAS the applicant proposes to reconstruct an existing rooftop sunroom which has fallen into a state of disrepair.

WHEREAS the proposed reconstruction will result in a rooftop sunroom that will copy the profile and dimensions of the existing sunroom and will be only minimally visible from the public way.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that this application is approved as presented.

This recommendation was approved by a vote of 45 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstentions, and 0 not voting for cause.
