- 2. Public Hearing: BSA Calendar No. 2016-1208-BZ, 300 East 64th Street-Application seeks to permit the operation of a physical culture establishment (fitness center) on the ground and second floors of the existing building at the Premises.

Applicant did not show up. The applicant invited to present at the March 9, 2016 Land Use meeting.

3. Street Life Committee – Laurence Parnes and Abraham Salcedo, Co-Chairs

1a. Mamericana, dba Gina Americana, 27 East 92nd Street (@Madison)-New application for an unenclosed sidewalk café with 9 tables and 18 Chairs. License/Application #16590-2015-ASWC. Due Date February 11, 2016

WHEREAS some members from the public had concerned to the size and color of any potential winter enclosure; and

WHEREAS the applicant agreed to ensure that any winter enclosure would be a muted (non-bright neon color) and the size would not encompass the entire size of the establishment; and

WHEREAS the applicant agreed to reduce the number of tables and chairs from 10 tables and 20 chairs to 9 tables and 18 chairs (the table to be removed shall be the 1 table with two chairs closest to the stairs of the neighboring home); and

WHEREAS the applicant has agreed to Community Board 8's stipulations concerning delivery bikes and bar crawls; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the application is **APPROVED**, subject to the stipulations in the recitals above **Manhattan Community Board 8 adopted the recommendation by a vote of 38 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstentions.**

1b. Sammy Musovic LLC., dba Selena Rosa, 1712 2nd Avenue (1st/2nd) -Renewal application for an unenclosed sidewalk café with 6 tables and 16 chairs. DCA #2015767-DCA. Due Date February 04, 2016 WHEREAS there are no changes to the café; and

WHEREAS no one from the public objected; and

WHEREAS the applicant has agreed to Community Board 8's stipulations concerning delivery bikes and bar crawls; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the application is **APPROVED** subject to the stipulations in the recitals above **Manhattan Community Board 8 adopted the recommendation by a vote of 38 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstentions.**

2a. Misohoppy LLC., dba Misohoppy, 1145 2nd Avenue (@60th Street)-Change in Method of Operation for Liquor, Wine and Beer

WHEREAS the committee was concerned with the hours request, especially since the initial application was initially approved by the committee in May and suggest license hours until 11pm Mon-Sun and the applicant agreed.

WHEREAS there are no other changes; and

WHEREAS no one from the public objected; and

WHEREAS the applicant has agreed to Community Board 8's stipulations concerning delivery bikes and bar crawls; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the application is **APPROVED**, subject to the stipulation that the hours of operation for the SLA license shall be until 12AM Monday through Sunday and the stipulations in the recitals above. **Manhattan Community Board 8 adopted the recommendation by a vote of 34 in favor, 3 opposed, 0 abstentions and 0 not voting for cause.**

3a. New HDM Inc., dba Hunan Delight Chinese Restaurant & Matsuya, 1467 York Avenue (@78th)-New application for Wine and Beer

WHEREAS the applicant had previously failed to appear before the committee on two separate occasions and **WHEREAS** the applicant explained that applicant had hired an expediter who inexplicably did not appear on applicants behalf, and

WHEREAS no one from the public objected; and

WHEREAS the applicant has agreed to Community Board 8's stipulations concerning delivery bikes and bar crawls; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the application is **APPROVED** subject to the stipulations in the recitals above Manhattan Community Board 8 adopted the recommendation by a vote of 38 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstentions and 0 not voting for cause.

3b. Botanicus Lexington Inc., DBA Le Botaniste, 833 Lexington Avenue (63rd/64th)-New application for Liquor, Wine and Beer

WHEREAS the applicant has agreed to Community Board 8's stipulations concerning delivery bikes and bar crawls; therefore

3c. Bear Noah Corp., dba Jacques Brasserie, 206 East 85th Street (2nd/3rd)-New application for Liquor, Wine and Beer

WHEREAS the applicant has agreed to Community Board 8's stipulations concerning delivery bikes and bar crawls; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the application is **APPROVED** subject to the stipulations in the recitals above Manhattan Community Board 8 adopted the recommendation by a vote of 38 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstentions and 0 not voting for cause.

3d. Tompad LLC., 1460 Second Avenue (76th/77th)-New application for Liquor, Wine and Beer

WHEREAS a member of the public object to the establishment; and

WHEREAS after further discussion the applicant agreed to reduce the hours requested for its SLA application by 1 hour on each day and thus will be Mon-Thurs 5pm to 1am, Fri-Sat 5pm to 2am and Sunday 7pm to 1am; and WHEREAS the applicant ensure that there is a doorman on at the entrance of the building who will ensure that only the number of customers in accordance with the venue capacity shall be admitted to the establishment and further shall at all time ensure that no customer may be granted access until any exiting customers have left the premises:

WHEREAS a manager or hostess shall escort and instruct any customers leaving the premises on the second floor to immediately leave the building and shall ensure that no customer is allowed on the third or 4th floor on the building or to loiter in the hallway or stairwell; and

WHEREAS the applicant shall ensure the venue is sound proofed to avoid bothering other resident in the vicinity; and

WHEREAS the applicant agreed to ensure that the venue windows will at all times remain closed; and WHEREAS the applicant agreed to only have low volume recorded music and never any live or loud recorded music; and

WHEREAS the applicant has agreed to Community Board 8's stipulations concerning delivery bikes and bar crawls; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the application is **DISAPPROVED**.

Manhattan Community Board 8 adopted the recommendation by a vote of 34 in favor, 4 opposed, 3 abstentions and 0 not voting for cause.

3e. Rodalo LLC., 133 East 61st Street (Park/Lex)-New application for Liquor, Wine and Beer

WHEREAS no one from the public objected; and

WHEREAS the applicant has agreed to Community Board 8's stipulations concerning delivery bikes and bar crawls; therefore
