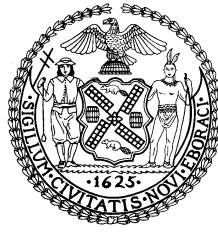

WHEREAS no one from the public objected, and

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the application is **approved**.

3b. Eat Madison 91 LLC, 26 East 91st Street (@Madison Avenue)-Alteration of Wine and Beer. Adding Sidewalk Café

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the application is **approved**.

Manhattan Community Board 8 adopted the recommendation by a vote of 31 in favor, 1 opposed, and 1 abstention.

3c. Stratos Bakery Corp., dba Bacado Bakery Café, 1297 Lexington Avenue (87th/88th)-Alteration of Wine and Beer.

WHEREAS this is solely to accommodate a modification of the interior seating, and

WHEREAS no one from the public objected, and

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the application is **approved**.

Manhattan Community Board 8 adopted the recommendation by a vote of 33 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstentions.

3d. Eat Lexington 87 LLC, dba Eli's Essentials, 1291 Lexington Avenue (@87th Street)-Alternation of Wine and Beer

WHEREAS this is solely to add the sidewalk cafe space to an existing license, and

WHEREAS on November 20, 2013, Community Board DISAPPROVED the issuance of a sidewalk café license for this location by a vote of 39 in favor, 2 opposed and 5 abstentions, and

WHEREAS the applicant has not been operating the sidewalk café and all our previous concerns regarding the high volume of foot traffic and potential noise issues at this corner remain,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the application is **DISAPPROVED**

Manhattan Community Board 8 adopted the recommendation by a vote of 24 in favor, 4 opposed, and 4 abstentions.

4a. Upper East Side Café, Inc., dba Bluestone Lane, 2 East 90th Street (@Fifth Avenue)-New application for Wine and Beer.

WHEREAS this is solely to accommodate a new operator for an existing establishment, and

WHEREAS no one from the public objected, and

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the application is **approved**.

Manhattan Community Board 8 adopted the recommendation by a vote of 28 in favor, 2 opposed, and 4 abstentions.

4c. Steven Kay, on behalf of entity to be determined, 1448 Second Avenue (75th/76th)-New application for Liquor, Wine and Beer.

WHEREAS there were no objections from the public, and

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the application is **approved** subject to the following stipulations which were agreed to by the applicant and are to be incorporated in the license's method of operation:

- The hours of operation for the SLA license will be:
Monday to Wednesday– 11:00am to 2:00am
Thursday to Saturday – 11:00am to 4:00am
Sunday– 10:00am to 2:00am
