Bike corrals are installed to accommodate high demand for bike parking in areas with insufficient space on the sidewalk.

Bike corrals are installed in the curbside lane of the street in a standard design that accommodates 8 bicycles.

Bike corrals are often installed in designated "No parking" or "No Standing Anytime" areas, or in a parking space.

Applicants agree to maintain the space by keeping the corral clear of snow and debris and reporting abandoned bikes.
