At its April 19, 2017 Full Board meeting, the Community Board voted to adopt the following resolution by a unanimous vote of 37 in favor, 0 opposed and 0 abstentions.

WHEREAS WIN is a non-profit that has successfully supported homeless women and their children; and

WHEREAS WIN has a long history of housing these families in shelters and scatter-site housing; and

WHEREAS is planning to lease a 7-story building to house 17 families at - 316 East 91st Street; and

WHEREAS this temporary congregate housing project will include on-site supportive services; and

WHEREAS Community Board 8M strongly urges WIN to provide 24/7 security at the site for the safety of the women and children who will reside there;

BE IT RESOLVED that Community Board 8, Manhattan approves of the WIN's 17-apartment congregate supportive housing program for women and children at 316 East 91st Street.
