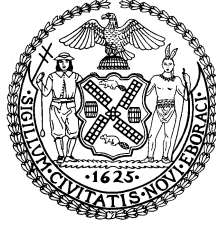

197-a QUEENSBORO BRIDGE AREA COMMITTEE
Phase III of Andrew Haswell Green (AHG) Park and Greenway
Site Visit to Former Sanitation Building on July 9, 2018

Board Members in attendance: M. Barry Schneider

Community Board Public Members: A. Scott Falk and Judith Schneider

Site visit included: EDC, Stantec, Parks, CB8 and members of the public.

Purpose of the site visit was to see the inside of the cavernous interior of the former transfer station and the south side of the exterior of the building where the Greenway will come into CB8. (See pictures)

The 40' path coming in on the south side of the building takes up much of what was thought could be a plaza. Therefore, drought tolerant greenery is probably the only solution for the rest of the space.

Main problem both inside and outside was noise from FDR. Sound barriers were recommended with some greenery.

Painting graffiti on the exterior columns is recommended and painting the interior walls and columns minimally, if there is no money for other work.

Questions arose about the barrier between the bike/pedestrian path and the rest of the interior. Parks said this has not been worked out at this point in time.

There will not be a committee meeting in July, it will be scheduled for September.
