RE: Request for a Change of Weekday Parking Regulations on East 64th Street between Lexington and 3rd Avenues from 8AM to 6PM from No Parking to No Standing

Dear Commissioner Trottenberg,

At the Full Board meeting of Community Board 8 Manhattan held on November 20, 2019, the board <u>approved</u> the following resolution by a vote of 43 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstentions, and 0 not voting for cause.

WHEREAS, there is an existing No Parking Weekdays 8AM to 6PM regulation on East 64th Street between Lexington and 3rd Avenues, and

WHEREAS, East 64th Street Lexington to 3rd Avenue Neighbors Association is requesting changes to parking to address regular illegal parking on this block by for hire vehicles and cars displaying illegally issued placards; and

WHEREAS, CB8 recognizes that parking placard legislative reform and additional enforcement are integral to addressing illegal parking, but are not viewed as likely to occur in a short-term timeframe;

WHEREAS, the existing No Parking regulations are an anomaly along East 64th Street, and

WHEREAS, the impacts of potential changes to parking on East 64th Street between Lexington and 3rd Avenues could potentially have adverse impacts on neighboring blocks if done in an uncoordinated manner;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Community Board 8 Manhattan requests that New York City Department of Transportation evaluate parking regulations based on a holistic approach that considers existing parking needs and land use across the entirety of East 64th Street between 5th Avenue and York Avenue, and report back with recommendations to CB8 in an expeditious manner.
