

On Tuesday, October 20<sup>th</sup>, the Voting Reform Task Force held the second of its series of public out-reach/committee meetings entitled "Voting November 2020."

The meeting was called to order by Voting Reform Task Force Co-Chair Shari Weiner. She explained the purpose of the zoom meeting was to educate the public on the variety of ways of voting this November which are early voting, voting by absentee ballot and voting in person on November 3, 2020.

Shari indicated this was the second public out-reach program. The speaker at the first meeting was Assemblyman Dan Quart who explained the new voting reform legislation passed in Albany.

Tonight's speaker was Susan Lerner, Executive Director of Common Cause NY. Ms. Lerner gave an excellent presentation elaborating on the three options available to vote in November. She provided the important dates the public needs to know: October 27, 2020, last day to apply for mailed absentee ballot, October 24-November 1, 2020, early voting, November 3, 2020, election days. After her presentation, Ms. Lerner answered questions from the public.

At conclusion of the meeting, Shari did a visual presentation on how to correctly fill out an absentee ballot, pointing out common pitfalls to avoid. Shari informed the public that she will be making a public service announcement video which will be available on the CB8 website on how to correctly fill out an absentee ballot.
