3. <u>New Business</u>

a. <u>The Green Kitchen, 1619 Second Avenue and 1475 First Avenue</u> -- Request for support of the reinstatement of their SLA License.

WHEREAS Green Kitchen had its liquor license suspended by the State Liquor Authority on October 25, 2020;

WHEREAS the suspension was due to several violations, including selling alcoholic beverages without an accompanying food purchase; allowing congregation of patrons in front of premises without facemask; allowing patrons to dine inside the premises; having employees that were not wearing facemasks; and serving patrons after curfew;

WHEREAS the applicant has asked Community Board 8 for its support in Green Kitchen's request to SLA to reinstate its license;

WHEREAS Green Kitchen has indicated that the suspension of its license is an undue hardship for the business;

WHEREAS Green Kitchen has developed a Remediation Plan (attached) to rectify the issues with the violations and to prevent future violations;

WHEREAS Green Kitchen's liquor license has been suspended for over 3 months at the date of the Street Life Meeting; and

WHEREAS the Street Life Committee views that given the current circumstances surrounding Covid-19 and that the suspension has been in effect for several months and provided that Green Kitchen continues to abide by the terms of the Remediation Plan;

BE IT RESOLVED that the request for a letter in support of reinstatement of Green Kitchen's liquor license is **APPROVED**, subject to the stipulations above.

Remediation Plan

- Demotion of Aris Kasimis as main operator of 1619 2nd location (Completed)
 - Aris previously worked under Constantine Kasimis (prior owner) before his covid-related death in March 2020
 - o Aris Kasimis to be replaced by Peter Kasimis and Vasili Karabatsos
- Implementation of zero strike policy for all staff (Completed)
 - o Failure to correctly wear masks at any time will result in immediate firing
- Hiring of full-time security staff (Pending)
 - Focus on surveying premises and mandating social distancing plus mandatory mask policy for all staff and patrons
- Removal of portable speakers from storefront (Completed)
 - Main cause of noise projection onto 2nd avenue and noise-related violations
- Installation of electric heaters along premises and removal of propane heaters (Completed)
 - o Propane tanks found in basement were empty and have since been removed
- Sidewalk obstructions removed (maintaining 8-foot clearance) (Completed)
 - Removed additional tables and potted plants
- Posting of all required signage, licenses and certifications on premises (Completed)
- Removed of Constantine Kasimis (deceased) from liquor license (Pending)
- Correction of temporary occupancy signage to reflect correct occupancy based on C of O (Completed)
- Fire extinguishers correctly mounted (Completed)
- Open flame candles replaced with battery powered candles (Completed)
 - Open flame candles were not being used at time of inspection
