




Located on East 62nd Street between Lexington Ave. and Park Ave. in the southern portion of the Upper East Side Historic District

1940s tax photograph


- Originally constructed 1869 70. Designed in Italianate
 style by Robert Mook
- Façade reconstructed in 1919
 in the late Beaux Arts style by
 Carrere and Hastings
- No areaway ironwork present historically

No areaway ironwork present at designation

- Only 3 rowhouses remain between 2 larger residential building








- Areaway fence approved by Certificate of No Effect 00-0096
- No curb, total height is 3'-6"
- Damaged by use of sidewalk salt and dog urine so requesting to also add a 4" stone curb at the base to protect new fence
