



#### New HSS Kellen Tower Building




- Centerpiece for Main Campus Transformation with new 12-story, 94,000 sqft building
- Increases space for advanced musculoskeletal care
- Last development opportunity over the FDR
- Physically connects to the Ambulatory Pavilion Building and has a new bridge connection to the Main Hospital
- Allows for modernization of the HSS Main Campus including an increase in the number of private rooms and less congestion
- It allows for highest and best use for our more complex clinical needs, increasing surgical and inpatient space in the Main Hospital Building



### Site Logistics Overview



- The site will include a temporary relocation of the pedestrian ramp at 71st street to allow the public continued access to the Esplanade southbound of 70<sup>th</sup> Street for the majority of the duration of the project.
  - There is an on-going improvement project by the Parks Dept. on the Esplanade from 68th to 70<sup>th</sup> Streets with an estimated completion in May 2022. This means the pedestrian bridge will not provide access to the Esplanade until that time.
- HSS's entrances will remain in place and the Kellen Tower will be accessed through existing HSS buildings
- The building allows HSS to right-size our services and allows us to relocate and expand the space for our existing services




■ = Temporary Pedestrian Ramp Location | | ■ = Additional Area of Esplanade Improvement

### Continued Collaboration for Esplanade Improvements









- Initial esplanade improvement from 70<sup>th</sup> to 72<sup>nd</sup> Streets (completed 2018)
- Continued improvement planned from 72<sup>nd</sup> to 78<sup>th</sup> Streets (construction coordinated with new building logistics)
- On-going coordination with NYC Parks
  Department on design
- Once approved, scheduling of construction to be completed in coordination with NYC DOT and the NYC Parks Department
- The existing pedestrian ramp from the 71<sup>st</sup>
  Street bridge will continue to serve access to
  the Esplanade southbound for most of the
  duration of the project

- On-going coordination on East River Esplanade design with NYC Parks Department and landscape architect Quennell Rothschild & Partners
- Once design is approved, logistical coordination and schedule determination begins with HSS, NYC DOT and Parks


