- How can we help the homeless on Roosevelt Island? Presentations by Serafina Payne from Manhattan Outreach Coordinator (MOC) Street Outreach Team. The goal is to gain their trust and bring them inside. We also had Leilani Irvin from the Department of Social Services (DSS). Both recommended reporting sightings of the unhoused through the City's 311 App. Now that the weather is getting colder our reporting of the individuals will help get them documented so that there will be better outreach done for them.
