

This property is located at the southeast corner of Madison Avenue and East 79<sup>th</sup> Street in the Metropolitan Museum Historic District.








Photo of current frieze showing measured dimension that is <12". LPC Rules: "A signband shall not include the frieze of a cornice that is less that 12" in height."

Signage dimensions (68.6" Wide x 7" High x 1" Deep)




Signage mounting detail. The lettering is only 1" deep and would not stick out very far from the building exterior.



Detail photo of signage, medium oxidized finish. The finish of the lettering is not that reflective and would blend in well with the exterior of the building.



Proposed signage above entry door (Photoshop). The signage would be legible and will replace the smaller, more hidden signage that is currently on the exterior wall behind the entry columns.

East 79<sup>th</sup> Street, looking southeast. The lack of signage at 20 East 79<sup>th</sup> Street makes the building seem like another residence.




Within one block within the historic district, there are at least two other art galleries that have been converted from originally designated residential buildings and have signage at the street entrance over the main entry door
