- 1. Presentation by Carlos Chavez, Manager of Roosevelt Island Public Library
 - Part of book giveaway totalling 500,000 books in Manhattan, Brooklyn and The Bronx

- **2. Redistricting.** Agreement over desire for Roosevelt Island to remain part of Manhattan politically, as described in the text below. This text is being circulated widely on Roosevelt Island.

"The Districting Commission is now working on rebalancing Council District populations based on the 2020 Census. Roosevelt Island is part of District 5 in Manhattan along with much of the Upper East Side. Our district will have to reduce its population by approximately 4,000-9,000 people.

There has been a suggestion by some members of the district that Roosevelt Island be moved into District 26 in western Queens. We believe this to be capricious and without appropriate and due consideration. From its inception Roosevelt Island has been a part of Manhattan - to move any part of our Governance would be detrimental to our community.

- The original purposeful intent was that Roosevelt Island be always considered a part of Manhattan. Roosevelt Island was Created to be a Manhattan Utopian Community by Mayor Lindsay.
- Roosevelt Islanders pay property taxes in Manhattan.
- Roosevelt Island schools are in DOE District 2 in Manhattan.
- Area code for Roosevelt Islanders was 212 not 718.
- Zip Code for Roosevelt Island is 10044, a Manhattan zip code.
- The MTA considers Roosevelt Island part of Manhattan.
- Included as part of the flat rate taxi fare as Manhattan
- Part of Manhattan Public Library System. Queens is separate.

Most importantly, for over 50 years the people who live on Roosevelt Island identify themselves as Manhattanites."
