## **Project Description**

- Located on First Avenue between E.79<sup>th</sup> & E.80<sup>th</sup> with 100' frontages on cross streets and 204' frontage on First Avenue
- Proposed 382,984 gross square-foot building
- Predominantly medical office space with ground floor retail
- Anchor tenant: Hospital for Special Surgery (HSS)
- Main pedestrian entrance is located on First Avenue
- HSS exclusive pick-up/drop-off area for ambulettes and taxis provided internally with attendant
- The attended pick-up/drop-off area to be accessed via new curb cut on open frontage E.80<sup>th</sup> Street

80<sup>TH</sup> STREET FRONTAGE



























### First Avenue Frontage Rendering


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







## **Nearby Parking**

- 47 facilities with total capacity of 4,356 spaces
  - 20 within two block radius
- Facilities were surveyed using DCA & ParkMe during last week of January 2022
- Overnight: 76% utilized, 1,038 available spaces
- 10 AM: 76% utilized, 1,064 available spaces
- PM: 66% utilized, 1,500 available spaces
- Similar utilization rates at 20 closest facilities



# Nearby Land Uses & Caedmon School

- Predominantly residential and mixed-use building, and to a lesser extent public & institutional buildings
- The most active nearby land use is the Caedmon School (part of adjacent church – St. Monica's)
- 190 enrollment (ages 2 to 10)
- Peak demand and operation hours:
  - 8:00-9:00AM, 11:15AM-12:00PM, & 3-4PM
  - Beginner or early programs (students < age 4) start at 8:45 AM and dismissed at 11:45AM, 3:30PM, or 5:45PM.
    K-5 (elementary) start at 8:30 AM and are dismissed at 3:30PM.
- Proposed curb cut is located ~185 feet from school entrance.



## **Nearby Activity**

Vehicular counts were conducted on E. 80<sup>th</sup> St – low vehicular activity

- AM 9:00 10:00am 78 vph (vehicles per hour)
- Midday 12:15 1:15pm 159 vph
- School PM 3:15 4:15pm 191 vph
- PM 4 5pm 194 vph

Pedestrians counts were conducted on south sidewalk of E. 80<sup>th</sup> St – consistent with adjacent uses AM – 8:00 – 9:00am – 330 pph (pedestrians per hour)

- Midday 11:30 12:30pm 135 pph
- School PM 3:00 4:00pm 260 pph
- PM 4:15 5:15pm 217 pph



## Sidewalk Suggestions

Line of sight of those using drop-off area & adjacent sidewalk


- Inbound drivers' line of sight would be partially obstructed by parked cars along south curb
- Outbound drivers' line of sight would be obstructed by the building wall along E.80<sup>th</sup> Street

Suggestions:

- Direct pedestrians away from building wall and into a path with line of sight for existing cars Remove parked cars near the corner that obstruct sight for arriving cars
- Sidewalk illumination
- Audio/visual alert systems for outbound vehicles
