Dear Deputy Commissioner Benedetto,

Applications will only be approved based upon the applicant's agreement to the following stipulations:

- 1. The applicant will abide by the bicycle guidelines and will ensure that any third-party delivery provider that it contracts with shall abide by the bicycle guidelines.
- 2. The applicant will not use any unlawful motorized vehicle for deliveries and ensure that any third-party delivery service you contract with does not use any unlawful motorized vehicle
- 3. The applicant will have delivery persons wear the proper attire such as helmets, identifiable clothing, etc. and ensure that any contracted third-party delivery service shall wear proper attire such as helmets, identifiable clothing etc.
- 4. The applicant will not participate in bar-crawls or the cannabis equivalent

At the Full Board meeting of Community Board 8 Manhattan held on March 20, 2024, the board unanimously approved the following resolution by a vote of 38 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstentions and 0 not voting for cause:

WHEREAS this is a New application for a Liquor, Wine, Beer, and Cider License and Temporary Retail Permit; and

WHEREAS no one from the public objected; and

WHEREAS the applicant agreed to the following stipulations regarding use of the rear yard of the establishment: 1) will not use the rear yard unless and until the applicant can provide CB8 with evidence of the lawful right to use the rear yard, either by a certificate of occupancy which clear demonstrates allowable rear yard use or by a letter of no objection from DOB for use of the rear yard, and 2) if and when lawful use of the rear yard is permitted, that the applicant will not use the rear yard past 10pm.

WHEREAS the applicant has agreed to Community Board 8's stipulations concerning delivery bikes and bar crawls and; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the application is APPROVED, subject to the stipulations above.
