Put it in:

 A labeled bin, 55 gallons or less, with a secure lid. Get a free label at nyc.gov/CompostingBinDecal.

ATTENTION property owners and managers: Beginning November 12, 2024, all trash must be set out in a bin (55 gallons or less) with a secure lid.

This applies to:

 single-family homes
two-family homes
buildings with up to 9 apartments

You can use a compliant bin (55 gallons or less with a secure lid) that you already have, but starting June 2026, you **MUST** use an **Official NYC Bin**.

The Official NYC Bin is durable, rat resistant, and **costs less than \$50** for the most-used size! **Order by October 1 to ensure delivery by November 12!**

Attention Business Owners: Fines for Cleanliness Violations Have Increased

Businesses are <u>required</u> to keep sidewalks and gutter areas clean.

Failure to do so will result in <u>escalating fines</u> for repeat offenses within a 12-month period.

Thank you for doing your part to keep NYC clean and send rats packing.

Violations Within a 12-month Period	Fine Amount
1 st	\$50
2 nd	\$300
3 rd +	\$500

Business Rules:

• Clean the sidewalk (including areas like tree pits, grass strips, etc.) and gutter areas (18 inches from the curb into the street) along the building perimeter.

 Do not block sidewalks. Call 311 to learn if signage or displays are allowed on your specific street.
