Introduction (6:24)

Paul Krikler thanked Judy Berdy for her contributions to the Committee before stepping down as a Public Member and welcomed Amy Namdar as a new Public Member to the Committee.

Item 1 – RIOC Update (8:06)

Bryant Daniels provided updates on:

- Road work on Main Street was postponed due to weather. It is now scheduled to start on May 12th, and last two weeks. The initial phase will target the worst areas of Main Street, including the Good Shepherd crosswalk. Z Bricks will be removed and replaced with asphalt.
- GPS tracking has been installed on all red buses except the smaller shuttle bus. The app is still not working as expected and will be remedied by the vendor.
- Roosevelt Island Day will be held on June 7th to celebrate the 50th anniversary of people moving to the island, with an expanded event at Firefighters Field.
- The weekend shuttle bus service to Manhattan has been extended for two more weekends (May 10th and May 17th). The shuttle bus runs on the hour from Roosevelt Island and on the half hour from Manhattan.
